Based on these survey results the MDC decided that if changes to the spring season were made they would favor all day hunting over an archery only spring turkey season. The reasoning was that more hunters would benefit from all day hunting than the archery only season. #### LARGE AND SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

In the January Conservation Committee article I promised I would ask about the MDC's 2012 Spring Turkey Hunting survey results. In that survey hunters were asked about a one week archery only season and an all day turkey spring seasons. I got to see those results this past weekend at the annual Conservation Federation of Missouri's annual convention held in Jefferson City. Here are the results of that survey.

Archery-only Spring Turkey Season;

**Support: 50.7%** Oppose: 28.8%

Neither support nor oppose: 20.5% All Day Spring Turkey Season

Support: 63.3%

Oppose: 24.2% Neither: 12.6%

When asked how likely it would be that survey respondents would participate in an archery only spring season;

Very likely: 37.4% Somewhat likely: 21.9% Not at all likely: 40.8%

### **Summary:**

Meeting called to order by Jason Hancock. Kathy recapped the old business that needed to be addressed:

• Schedule for MBH 600 Round to be hosted by Indian Trail- Faron made a motion to hold the tournament on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Darryl Cooney seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

## New business was presented to the group:

- The date for the MBH State 3D Championship is currently scheduled for the same weekend as the NFAA Sectional Outdoor (hosted IBH). Jerry Denker made a motion to move the date to July 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Discussion was held regarding the conflict with the Show Me Games Target completion, but it was determined that there weren't any better alternatives. The motion was seconded by Darryl Cooney. The motion was passed.
- The annual MBH bow raffle is supposed to be drawn at the last State Championship tournament in order to raise as much money as possible. At the last meeting, it was agreed that the bow would be drawn at the MBH State Outdoor Championship. Based on the new tournament date of August 18<sup>th</sup> (which is AFTER the State Outdoor), Dan Jasa made a motion to move the raffle to August 18<sup>th</sup> at the MBH 600 Round. Sam Maucelli seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

The next MBH BofR meeting will be held at the State Outdoor Championship. Meeting adjourned.





# News From The Stump....

March has finally arrived! This is THE MONTH most Spot Shooters look forward to each year. Having put many hours of practice in at the range and testing their skills at local, state and sectional tournaments... the time for NFAA Indoor Nationals has arrived!! A significant number of Missouri Shooters will be making the trip to Louisville. For others, it's time to switch over to 3D and/or field rigs. A few Shooters will simply take a break to relax and recharge before preparing for hunting season. Whatever group you fall into... March is all about transition!

Thanks to all of you that participated in our NFAA Midwest Sectional Indoor Tournament this year. I've been comparing this years results to the previous year and all I can say is ... WOW!! We had 326 Shooters participate this year which represents a 22% increase over last year.

Being somewhat of "math nerd", I couldn't stop there.

I took a deeper dive into the data and uncovered some other interesting statistics:

- Missouri hosted 37% of the Shooters. South Dakota hosted 35% and lowa hosted 28%. The location with the most significant grow compared to 2012 was lowa (+59%).
   first meeting will be April 12th. I'n excited about the possibilities, but extremely cautious about ensuring each organization is able to maintain their identity. Just a reminder
- Females made up 28% of Shooters. anything.
   There was a whopping 43% increase in the number of female shooters compared to last year. Participation by males increased by only 15%.
- From a division perspective, the largest level of growth was in the Young Adult division (+70%)! Coming in 2nd place was the Cub division with (=56%). Third place went to the Youth division with (+27%). This is VERY encouraging!

Most of you know that I stepped down as MBH Secretary/Treasurer this year.

Well my free time didn't last long. I've been officially asked to represent NFAA on a 4 person committee that will be meeting with a similar group from the NAA. #### CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

I have just returned from Jefferson City where during this past weekend the Conservation Federation of Missouri held its annual convention. This convention happens every year at the end of February and is arguably one of the most important events of the year for all people who enjoy the great Missouri Outdoors. This weekend gathering involves CFM members from all over the state and 75 different affiliated clubs that encompass everything from the Anglers of Missouri to Jefferson City Coon Hunters to the Missouri Prairie Association to the Missouri Wild Turkey Federation to the Ozark Fly Fishers and of course our club the Missouri Bow Hunters Association. The objectives of this convention are many but one of the most important things we do during the two day workshop is to past resolutions from the 14 different committees that cover things like wildlife regulations, water quality, recycling, forestry, sportsman's rights, and conservation education just to name a few. These resolutions are the recommendations of the conservation minded citizens of Missouri and are passed along to the appropriate organization to be acted on. Whether it is the Missouri Department of Conservation or the Department of Natural Resources or the Missouri Legislature and Governor, each resolution will require a response of action taken or plans enacted. I participated in the Archery Committee and the Deer, Wild Turkey, & Elk Commit-

In the Archery committee we passed 2 resolutions;

 Currently the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) and several other organizations provide grant money to Missouri schools to start up Archery in the Schools programs. This resolution was to ask that a maintenance fund be established to allow up keep of the equipment & targets to help continue the program in schools that are already participating.

2. Request that the MDC consider extending the antler point restriction exemption to those young bowhunters who purchase the Youth Deer and Turkey permits. In other words remove any antler point restrictions for youth bowhunters.

In the Deer, Wild Turkey, & Elk Committee we passed 3 resolutions;

- Request that the MDC reevaluate the current antlerless deer permit allowances and reduce the number of antlerless permits in the counties where the deer populations are declining.
- 2. Urge the MDC to impose a moratorium on any new high fenced hunting/breeding facility of cervids, and or any other non-native species that threaten to negatively impact Missouri's native flora and fauna.
- 3. The third resolution includes an 11 step recommendation to the MDC, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, and the Missouri Legislature to focus all resources and move quickly to provide the statutory and regulatory structure required to minimize, contain, and eliminate the threat to the wild herd of Whitetail Deer caused by CWD.

At the committee meetings we did hear reports from MDC biologists Jason Isabelle for Turkey and Jason Summers for deer. Turkey and Jason Summers for deer. These reports are very interesting and show that the MDC is doing its homework to manage our wild turkey & deer population.

One area that I think the MDC is failing in recently is what they are doing to try and control the Chronic Wasting Disease that has been found in Macon County. The first case of CWD in Missouri was discovered in 2010 at a high fenced big game hunting preserve in Macon and Linn Counties. Since that time there have been 11 confirmed cases of CWD found on that hunting preserve. All of the cervids in that facility were destroyed; unfortunately there have been 6 more cases found in the wild deer population. All 6 deer were killed within 2 miles of the northwest corner of the high fenced hunting preserve.

The MDC has implemented a plan that basically calls for the severe reduction of the deer population in the designated six county CWD zone. This is necessary to slow down the spread of the disease as much as possible. The failure comes in the regulation of the approximately 304 currently permitted confined deer businesses across Missouri. That's right I said over THREE HUNDRED fenced deer operations. There are about 27 high fenced hunting preserves and another 277 permitted deer breeding farms in Missouri. Currently the Missouri Department of Agriculture is responsible for the captive deer farm regulations but the regulations are not very stringent and are designed to protect the economic interests of the industry rather than the protection of the public wild deer herd.

The MDC needs to regulate the captive deer industry and make it a priority to protect Missouri's wild deer herd not the deer farmers!
