

# 2012 Hall of Fame inductees

The Missouri Bow Hunters Hall of Fame Committee proudly announces the induction of two of their members into the Hall of Fame.

Frank Tolivar at 84 has been an active member for over 53 years. He reported his first small game report in 1959 and received his first award in 1960 and went on to earn 7 small game awards. He has harvested at least one deer for 55 consecutive years with archery equipment and has taken 45 turkeys. Most impressive feat is Frank has earned 12 consecutive Grand Slam awards. Frank Tolivar represents the "Hunter" in MBH.

Don Roper a long time member of the MBH was awarded a life time membership in 1991 for his devotion to the Large and Small Game Committee. For many years Don was the chairman of the Large and Small Game committee keeping statistics of how members harvested their game and awards. Don is probably most remembered as the "Father of Bow Hunter Education" in Missouri. He spent countless hours and drove many miles to educate not only MBH members but anyone wanting to learn about bow hunting.
