Greetings brothers and sisters of the bow. We are halfway through December, I hope your 2010 Missouri bow season has been as excellent as mine has. God has genuinely blessed me with many fantastic opportunities and memories I will cherish for the rest of my life, the epitome of what a year in archery should be like. Over the last couple months,

I have told you about some of the exciting experiences I witnessed this (refer to October's Release for more details). Luckily, I have an addition to the list of unforgettable moments of this prosperous season.

It was October 31st and the leaves were steadily changing colors, falling off the trees. I knew the deer activity was going to pick up dramatically at any time. Whether it was with a gun or bow, I had a buck on just about every last weekend of October I have ever hunted. Three bucks as a youth with a firearm and one buck with a bow in 2008 to be exact. I grabbed the blaze orange and the bow and headed out with my dad to see what we could do. We hunted a valley, my dad the upper in the big timber, while I the lower by the creek bottoms. We were about 200 yards apart. The morning was calm and the leaves were dry and crunchy. I set up on the south facing side of the valley, in front of a downed log, overlooking a creek. Just as shooting light came to be, I heard the familiar sound of deer walking in the brush. I grabbed my Knight and Hale grunt call and called softly. From out of nowhere, I see a buck walking down the creek. I counted the points to see that this buck yielded 5 on one side of his rack. At that time, I noticed the huge mass of the antlers and the immense size of his body. Immediately, I knew this was the biggest deer I had ever seen, none the less got a shot. I came to full draw with my trusty Elite GT500 bow and anchored. The buck was at 33 yards. Suddenly a doe was 30 yards behind me blew and put the buck on alert. It was too late, though. I had the pin on "the" spot and let the Muzzy fly. I shortly holding a main frame 10 pointer with 13 scoring points and weighing 300 pounds on huff. The monster, I now call the Creek Bottom Gangster, scores 153 5/8 inch.

I give God all the glory for blessing me with a chance to harvest one of his finest creatures. By now, the State NFAA -MBH Indoor Championship is over and congratulations to everyone. I will be attending, so, I will be able to comment on it next month. I am sure it was another excellent event. Aim small and God Bless.


How the time flies – here we are in 2011 already and we are completing our first indoor league of the season and getting ready to start the second to lead us into the tournament season.



CHILI RECEIPE ... for strong or tough venison

1-2 lb. of ground venison or cut into 1" cubes

1 cup of chopped onions

1/2 cup chopped green peppers

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 14 1/2 oz. can of tomatoes, chopped

1 15 oz. can dark red kidney beans, rinsed & drained

1 8 oz. can tomato paste

2-3 teaspoons of chili powder

1/2 teaspoon basil

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

Place venison, onion, pepper and garlic in a large sauce pan and brown in about 2 tablespoons of oil. Add the remainder of ingredients and bring to boil. Reduce heat, cover and simmer for 30 minutes to an hour until meat is tender.

I call it the "**First Deer Woods**". It's where I shot my first deer ever with a bow October 19, 1998. I returned to that section of woods and, in fact, the same tree on October 7, 2010. It was a wonderful morning, the sun was creeping over the hill and warmed my left side. The squirrels and birds were waking with the brightening sky. Time I so enjoy taking in. As I sat, I watched a fox squirrel dance out on the tiny branches that had no right holding him. He defied them and went about his business of plucking acorns from the nearby oaks. His winter coat was slick and soft looking. So was the doe's coat that appeared along the hillside. I felt a quiet excitement as she browsed. There was another doe several more yards up the hill. I kept my attention to the nearest doe as I stood and turned in my stand. She was quickly approaching my 25 yard multi-flora rose bush on my right. I brought my Martin recurve into position and only had to wait a minute for her to pause and check the other doe up the hill. I put my pin behind her shoulder and shot strong. She bolted

and the woods were noisy as she ran and crashed 40 yards away. I immediately began to tremble and was thankful for the opportunity to be in the woods and harvest a deer with a bow.

I have been shooting a bow for 12 years. The last two years I have embarked on a new archery journey shooting an Olympic-style recurve with the help of Larry Skinner. I enjoy all types of archery but I find the Olympic-style especially physically challenging. I hunt with a 40 pound Martin Jaguar recurve and at times a Parker compound. This is the second deer I have harvested with my recurve. My compound has helped me harvest numerous deer and a few turkeys over the last twelve years.
