Conservation Committee

If you read my report last month you know that Senate Bill 300 was a real concern not because it would have allowed centerfire handguns to be used during the muzzle-loader deer season but because it would set hunting methods via state legislation, bypassing the Missouri Department of Conservation. Those efforts were defeated thanks to all who let their legislators know that is not the best course of action for Missouri's wildlife.

Dave Murphy the Executive Director of the Conservation Federation of Missouri had this to say about the recent legislative session; "Perhaps the greatest achievement for the conservation community this session was the defeat of several bills and amendments. Efforts to set hunting methods via legislation failed. Also various attempts to challenge the North American Model for Conservation, where wildlife is held in the public trust, were defeated. Wildlife belongs to all of us Americans, not to a royal family, not to the government, and not to individual landowners".

It was great to see & shoot with some of you at the State 3D Tournament in May.

I learned a few valuable lessons at that shoot. You see I thought I would try my hand at Traditional Archery this year to see if I could become proficient enough with my recurve to possibly harvest a deer this fall with it. I finished a distant 7th place in the traditional class. Top ten sounds good until you realize that only 7 traditional shooters entered. I learned I am not ready yet! Unless I can get that deer within 15 yards standing broadside perfectly still. I want to say thanks to the guys I shot with on Saturday for not being too hard on this novice. I have got a long ways to go to shoot as well as Don, John, Jim, & Effie.

Don't Forget Your Confidence

The baseball legend Yogi Berra once said, "This game is 90% mental half the time." The same can be said about archery in almost any instance. Most all archers have heard and understood that the majority of our aiming and releasing is controlled primarily by our mind through our subconscious. Once one can somewhat gain control of this, they can improve their archery game substantially. But after all this talk of the subconscious and what not, I think we miss something that is nearly, if not even more important. This crucial element is confidence. Over the last couple months, I have been assistant coach of a NASP archery team at a private school in my home town. Through the process of working with the students on their form and technique for a period of time, the head coach and myself had grown our team into a finely tuned shooting machine. Everything looked great. Their form was that of world champs and they were putting in scores that blew my mind. Hey, they made it to Nationals someway, right? Anyways, I noticed a common occurrence in practices that happened to a couple shooters each practice. It was not the same shooters each time. It varied from person to person. I thought this was quite the occurrence. So, one day I watched one of the more advanced shooters on the team. She is a very competent shooter and she was putting in a great game. The first couple rounds at 10 meters were between 48 and 50 (50 being 5 10's). Once we moved back to the 15 meter line, she continued the great round with a 48. On the second set of arrows at 15 though, she had one arrow jump from an average of 9's and 10's all the way out to a 5. She shot a 42 that round. Suddenly her next, and last round of the game dropped to a 34. Ouch!!! I sat down with her after the round and asked her what happened. Basically, she let that one 5 got in her head and she suddenly though her whole game was down the drain. The moral of the story is, when one makes a bad shot, or more so misses a deer, you need to remember the 50 great shots you have made lately instead of the one bad shot. If you let the bad shot haunt you, it will hurt your shooting. Remembering those good shots, though, will strengthen your mental stimuli. When you strengthen the mental stimuli, your confidence will soar and so will your scores. Always remember, once you release that arrow, there's no way of getting back that shot. If it's a good shot, remember it and relish in the glory of making a good shot. If it wasn't quite so good, tell yourself, "Hey, we all make a bad shot here and there. I can do better that that. I have shot better than that!" After that, focus on the next shot. I hope this little nugget of archery information will help someone out there.
