But almost every season I can rely on reports from several die hards in the organization and this year was no exception.

3. Frank Tolivar, Wheatland, 16 lb. tom, 5" beard, 22 yard shot, taken at 12:15 pm on May 8th in Hickory Co. #43 in 54 years.

Several months back, I read an interesting article, and if you are like me and have several young grand children or small children of your own, you might enjoy how this particular "term" came about.

On Nov.14th, 1902 President Theodore Roosevelt, while helping to settle a border dispute between Mississippi and Louisiana, went on a bear hunt in Mississippi. After three days of no success, the guide dogs finally found an old mature sow. The chase was on. The dogs caught and attacked the bear. The bear killed one of the dogs, then the dogs wore the old bear down enough that guides were able to rope the tired bear to a tree. President Roosevelt was contacted, but refused to shoot the injured bear for sport, but ordered the mercy killing of the animal.

Hunters and non-hunters alike applauded Roosevelt's ethical, fair chase standard. Political cartoonist Clifford Berryman illustrated the event. The cartoon was called "Drawing the line in Mississippi", depicted both the state line dispute and the bear hunt. Berryman drew the bear to be a cuddly cub. The cartoon drawing of the cuddly cub and the story told became so popular that within a year the cartoon bear became a toy for children, called the "teddy bear". 
# Receipe Pulled Venison

It seems that a slow cooker and venison go together, and this months recipe is no exception.

4-5 lb. venis	on roast	1 "	liquid smoke
1 1/2 cups of	l ketchup	2 "	celery salt
2 tablespoon	s brown sugar	2 teaspoons	Worcestershire sauce
1 "	ground mustard	1 "	onion powder
1 "	lemon juice	1/8 "	ground nutmeg
2 "	soy sauce	3 drops hot	pepper sauce

Cut roast in half and place in slow cooker, combine ingredients in large bow and pour over roast. Cover and cook on high for 4- 5 hours or until meet is tender. Remove roast, set aside to cool. Shred meat, return to sauce and reheat. Serve on bread or roll. Enjoy !


# from Cole Duensing.... It's Only Two Months Away!
