



# Technology & Archery Go Hand in Hand

Henry Taylor once said, "The hope, and not the fact, of advancement, is the spur to industry." This premise is exactly what has driven the archery industry for many years now. The bow companies come out with a faster or smoother bow, the sight companies come out with brighter pins, the arrow companies make a straighter arrow, and so on. This year coming is no different. The advancement of the archery industry has been as much as any other industry, except maybe some kind of computer or phone industry. To look at the advancements in the last few years alone is incredible. For instance, we now see carbon fiber material in everything! This extremely strong yet unbelievably light material has dominated the arrow industry for years has now evolved into sights, quivers, and one of the most unmistakable bows of the history of the industry, the Hoyt Carbon Matrix, Element, and Matrix Plus. Another trend in today's bow world is the "speed" bow. Now, whether or not you like these short brace height bows, pushing upwards of 360+ fps, they are still an incredible technological advancement. It will be very interesting to see what the bow companies will focus on as the new bows of the year are, and a few are already, released. Another huge advancement in the industry is arrow technology. Now, we are seeing multi-spine arrows for enhanced down range flight, extremely accurate "fat" shafts, and micro diameter arrows that can penetrate through the thickest game hides. Along with these technology leaps, sights have become more accurate, quivers became lighter, binoculars clearer, tree stands safer, and releases more consistent. All of this has led to the sport of archery opening up to a wider following, improved efficiencies, incredible accuracy, and a more user friendly sport. We have seen archery become a technologically advanced, high tech, improved upon sport that helps us all do what we love the most, ethically kill game animals or pound the center of a target. So the next time you're in the stand or at the shooting line, think about how far we've come. For the advancement in the years to come will lead us into the future and helping make our sport stronger than ever before.

The Missouri Department of Conservation along with Mississippi State University has put together a great website where you can learn all about the project. You can even track the bears they have radio collared and see their movements on a map. Be sure to watch the short video on the home page and listen to what MDC biologist Jeff Beringer has to say about how they are captured and the DNA sampling they are doing. The tracking page along with the info about each bear was really interesting. A couple of the males they captured are almost 500 pounders! The really cool thing about this project is that we as hunters can all say we helped restore the bear population in the state of Missouri through the dollars we spend on licensees, archery gear, and other outdoor recreational equipment we purchase every year. Part of the taxes that we pay on our gear goes towards funding projects like this one as well as habitat preservation and improvements.

Hope your hunting season is going well. So far I have gotten out three times but have not loosed an arrow yet. It's still early though and better hunts are coming.
