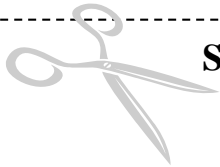

Summer Sausage RECIPE (use up the ground venison still in the freezer)

Here is a recipe that can be used with all that ground venison still in the freezer. Although on a day much like we are having, venison chili would really hit the spot
2 lbs. of ground venison

- 1 cup of water
- 3 table spoons of quick cure salt
- 1/4 teaspoon of pepper
- 1/8 teaspoon of garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon of onion salt
- 1/2 teaspoon of mustard seed
- 1 tablespoon of liquid smoke

Mix all ingredients well. Shape on aluminum foil in 2 rolls. Twist ends of rolls to secure. Refrigerate for 24 hours. Place in kettle and cover with water and boil for 1 hour. Remove and punch holes in foil to drain water. Enjoy!

The tryouts were conducted on 3 separate weekends, spanning over 3 months. With an increasing number of participants this year, 32 shooters total tried out for a spot on one of the archery state teams. The weekends were setup to be mock events of what will be expected in actual competition at Nationals. Shooters competed in 3-D, Field and FITA. Tryouts were intense but fun.

What is the commitment these young shooters, parents and coaches make to represent Missouri State 4H? Those that make the team are dedicated to focusing on their archery skills that are needed for the particular class they will compete in. Over the next 6 months, these shooters will live and breathe either the compound or recurve bow by only shooting compound or recurve, not switching back and forth.

They will be critics of their shooting styles, learn to identify, make adjustments to shooting styles, equipment, practice independently, attend team practices, maintain a shooters log book that is reviewed by shooter and coach at each practice, a positive role model and mentor, maintain good standing in their local 4H clubs by participating in club events and community service events, strengthen life skills, most of all, represent Missouri having the best experience they can!

MBH's sponsorship will be used to support the Compound and Recurve teams at practice over the next several months, and for food expenses while in Texas, June 2011. We truly appreciate the awesome support we receive from MBH. Not only for the 4H State teams, but also at every shoot that our young men and women participate in.

Thank you again for your strong support in helping our youth achieve success by strengthening their shooting skills and life skills. Participating in an opportunity that truly is once in a lifetime. The first order of business was to count votes for the MBH officer election. Steve Christian was elected President and Bill Myer was elected Vice President. Steve then officially appointed Kathy Potter to serve as MBH Secretary Treasurer.

Provided below is a summary of the other items addressed during the meeting:

MBH State Outdoor Championship Tournament

The Board heard bids and awarded the 2011 State Outdoor tournament to Independence Bow Hunters. The date will be August 6th & 7th, 2011. As in previous years, MBH will take care of registrations and payouts/awards. MBH will pay IBH a flat fee of \$300 for coordinating, executing all other aspects of the tournament. MBH/NFAA membership will be required.

MBH State 3D Championship Tournament

Bids for the State 3D championship were heard and the 2011 State 3D Championship tournament was awarded to Owl Creek Archery (formerly known as Millersburg Archery. On May 14th/15th, 2011 with a shotgun start on both days. MBH will pay registrations and payout/awards. MBH will pay OCA a flat fee of \$10 per adult shooter. The course will consist of 2 ranges, 18 targets on each range. Participants may shoot either day and enter multiple times, only the 1st score will be considered for awards. MBH/NFAA membership not required.

MBH State Indoor Championship Tournament

Discussion was held and the Board agreed (by majority vote) that NFAA membership would not be required for the MBH State Indoor Championship (to be held in March). A budget of \$6,200 was approved to cover tournament expenses.

NFAA State Indoor Championship Tournament

The board further agreed to hold a separate NFAA State Indoor Championship tournament on Sunday, December 18th, 2011. The fee for adults will be \$20 and the fee for Youth and Cubs will \$15.

The tournament will again be held at multiple sites across the state. Host clubs will be paid \$5 per shoot and MBH will pay for targets and awards. Any MBH/NFAA Chartered Club may submit a proposal to host the event in their respective area of the state. Proposals must be received by April 15th the final decision will be made at the May BofR meeting to be held at the MBH State 3D, Saturday, May 14th. Request for proposals will be printed in February, March and April Release publications.

2011 Missouri Deer Classic

The decision was made for MBH to once again Sponsor the Missouri Deer Classic. It was decided to hold a Vegas 300 round tournament during the event using the same format as 2010. Entry fee for all ages will be \$15 and at participants may enter multiple times and submit their highest score for consideration of awards. A budget of \$200 was allocated for youth trophies

MBH T-Shirts and Novelties

The board agreed to allocate \$2,300 for the purchase of T-shirts and novelties that will be sold during 2011 MBH events. The tournament coordinator will assume responsibility for making final selections/decisions

MBH Web Services

The board acknowledged the great job provided by Terry Whitford for management of the MBH website and approved payment for web service fees and support in the amount of \$400 for 2011

4H State Shooting Sports

The board agreed to support and sponsor the 4H State Shooting Sports archery teams by donating \$500 toward the expenses will be incurred y the 8 team members would will be representing Missouri during the 2011 National contest.

Appointments

Bil Myers accepted the role of Tournament Coordinator for 2011. Jeff Blystone agreed to serve as the MBH representative for the Conservation Federation of Missouri. The board also agreed to pay the costs for Jeff to represent MBH at the 2011 annual CFM conference (not to exceed \$500). Kent Hayes volunteered to take over coordination of the Youth Bow Fishing shoot for 2011. The board agreed to purchase T-Shirts for the Youth BowFishing participants. 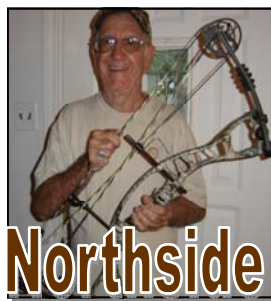
