He has represented MBH at the Conservation meetings, as well as being active with the Bow Hunter defense committee. He and Diane have been regulars at the MBH table at the Missouri Deer Classic For many of the twenty plus years, too. After all of these years, Jack has decided to step down from his position. Luckily for MBH, Jeff Blystone has agreed to pick up where Jack left off. Jeff has been the Conservation Commission Representative for the past year. This will be a real good fit for everybody involved. Jeff will be at the MBH booth at the Deer Classic next month along with Jack on Saturday. CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

As I write this I am reflecting on the many changes that are taking place as a result of the MBH Board of Representatives meeting that happened on January 15, 2012. Change is difficult to accept but it is a fact of life. We can both accept it and work to make it benefit MBH or be stubborn and walk away. The changes are documented in the B of R minutes and are posted on the MBH website. You should make it a point to read them over especially since starting in June of this year that will be the only way you can read about the Missouri Bow Hunters Club. For those of you that do not have a computer I will be counting on your fellow club members to print off a copy of the "Release" for you to read. Another change will be the passing of the Large & Small Game Committee duties from longtime chairman Jack Davis to yours truly. I hope I can continue the outstanding service that Jack has given to the MBH members for the last 20 plus years. Jack and I will be at the Missouri Deer Classic on March 3&4, 2012 to hand out last years awards and to tell hunt'in stories to anyone who will listen so come by and see us at the MBH booth this year.

On February 24, 25, & 26 my wife Kim (who is also an MBH & CFM member) & I will be attending the annual Conservation Federation of Missouri convention at the Lodge of the 4 Seasons Lake of the Ozarks. We hope to represent the MBH point of view at the Archery Committee and Deer, Turkey, & Elk Committee meetings. Hopefully by now you have seen or heard about the survey I sent to all of the MBH Archery Clubs listed in the Release and have had a chance to voice your opinion. If not give me a call or send an email and I will fill you in. If I don't answer please leave a message and I will return your call.

Enough with the business stuff. It is the time of year when we should all be outdoors scouting and shed hunting. Deer sign really stands out this time of year and you don't have to worry about spooking the deer while trying to hunt them. Put a trail camera on a green field and you can see how many of those big bucks made it through the hunting season. The camera will also show you when the antlers drop from those bucks. I have had the best luck finding sheds in brassicas (turnip) food plots in late February and early March. Below is a picture of our pup and some of last years sheds.

Hunting Season Wrap Up- Harvested my forth doe of the season on New Years Eve. I did also miss a nice buck at 35yds, it was too dark to see and I never should have taken that shot. I also missed a turkey at 30yds that was roosted in a tree. Three of the does were harvested inside the Kansas City limits on urban hunting land. The other doe was just outside of the urban zone in Platte County. One deer was donated to Share the Harvest the other three were given to family and friends who were unsuccessful or no longer hunt. My wife and I also harvested a couple of deer during rifle season and we kept those for ourselves.



There is still several days before the deadline for reports and those to receive awards, will be contacted. If one is to receive an award and can't make the Deer Classic but knows of a friend that will be there, it would save on mailing expense if that friend could pick it up for you.

With all the years I've been hunting, I feel as though I could write a book of my experiences, and I'm sure many of you could do the same. But this past season I had an incident that I thought I would share with you.

While sitting on my tree stand in the pre dawn light in early Dec., in urban area outside of Camdenton, I noticed what appeared to be a deer moving off a ridge top some 80-90 yards away. He was traveling at a quick pace for a bit then stop. As he got closer, I noted a white patch over his face. I wasn't sure just what I was seeing, thinking he was part albino. As he moved closer, some thirty yards, I noted it was a plastic Wal-mart bag and some how the handles were caught on either side of his 4 pt. antler. When he ran, the bag would bellow and he could see where he was going, but when stopped the bag would fall across his face and he could not see. He came within 10 yards from my stand and when stopped would shake his head vigorously trying to rid the bag. He put on quite a show for it seemed as long as 5 minutes. He then ran some distance to where my hunting partner was perched, giving him the same show. At the time I was humored but soon felt saddened that I could not help. But one thing for sure, I was hunting urban deer.

With regret, I'm stepping down from the Large & Small Game Committee. I have pondered this for some time, feeling it is time for a change and move on with my retirement. Looking back over the records, I have held this position for some twenty-one years taking it over from Don Roper. Anyone that knows Don, knows that was some pretty big shoes to fill, and I hope I did it wisely. Through this position it helped me get more involved in archery. For twenty plus years I worked the Mo. Deer Classic, for thirteen years I chaired and co-chaired the archery committee for the Conservation Federation of Missouri, became a bowhunter ed. instructor for the MDC, which I will continue to do, became a member of the Missouri Outdoor Communicators (MOC) in thanks for the monthly articles I wrote, sat in several community meetings with MDC personnel promoting bowhunting to solve their ever ending deer problem. But most of what I enjoyed, was ever ending list of friends I have met along the way. I know Jeff will do a good job and keep those reports coming in!

The RELEASE newsletter expense

Multiple options discussed at length. Final decision: MBH will stop mailing the RELEASE effective June 1st 2012. The newsletter will continue to be uploaded to the MBH website, monthly. The online version will be password protected. Monthly email notifications will be distributed by the MBH Secretary when the RELEASE is uploaded.

The MBH website

The motion for agenda item #1 included the protection of the MBH RELEASE from public viewing. Discussion was held and Kathy will work with Terry to make further updates to the site targeted at promoting MBH and its sponsors. MBH will unprotect sponsor advertisements and club directory information.

Discussion held regarding the process for managing membership security for protected information on the MBH website. Terry and Kathy will work together to create a process for assigning IDs and passwords. Associated decision: MBH annual membership dues become due on March 1st effective 2012 and pro-rated accordingly. Kathy will work with NFAA HQ to create a process to eliminate MBH overcharges to Members who pay via the NFAA website.

Discussion held regarding the work Terry has completed to update the MBH website. The board expressed gratitude for Terry's generosity to MBH and agreed to pay Terry Whitford \$400, which included both the webmaster and website hosting expenses for 2012

Missouri Deer Classic

Discussion was held regarding MBH participation in previous Missouri Deer Classic events. Final decision: MBH not sponsor the Missouri Deer Classic for 2012. MBH will host an Indoor 330 Vegas tournament and have a booth at the event in lieu of a full page add in the February issue of the RELEASE and 25% of the tournament net profit as long as it is agreed to in writing and by the Missouri Deer Classic. Jeff Friedman agreed to serve as the tournament director for the 2012 Missouri Deer Classic shoot and MBH to cover up to \$300 for his expenses and up to \$500 for officer and volunteer expenses.

Ragan Sappington spoke on behalf of 4H Shooting Sports and offered the assistance of 3 4-H members to help on Friday and Sunday with setup and tear down related to the MBH Shoot.

Promoting Youth in MBH

MBH will offer a reduced individual annual membership of half the total adult membership amount for individuals that are 17 years of age or younger.

MBH will hold an annual multi location Junior Missouri Bow Hunter tournament beginning in 2012 for members who are 17 years of age and under. Faron Teague will serve as the tournament chair and Ragan Sappington will serve as co-chair. Up to \$200 was designated for awards and the entry fee not exceed \$15 per individual.

Discussion was held regarding the creation of a PeeWee division for an age group below Cubs. Because MBH bylaws state that NFAA tournament guidelines will be followed, a change of this nature would require a change to the MBH bylaws. Further research will be conducted to determine if there is significant interest before pursuing a new division.

2012 tournaments

No bids were submitted for the 2012 MBH State 3D tournament. Carl Ball suggested that a document be created and distributed to the BofR's explaining how the bid process work and what information is required. Kathy will create and distribute a document with the information. The bid deadline MBH 3D has been extended and all bids will be reviewed at the MBH State Indoor tournament in March. Independence Bow Hunters will host the 2012 MBH State outdoor Field tournament July 14th- 15th using the same terms and conditions as documented in 2011.

Discussion was held about the increase in participation for the Missouri ShowMe Games outdoor round. Several members have expressed interest in participating in a similar MBH outdoor event. Based on the discussion, it was agreed that MBH will accept bids for a 2012 MBH 600 Outdoor Tournament. All bids will be reviewed at the MBH State Indoor tournament in March.

Separate Indoor Championships for MBH and NFAA

Discussion was held regarding the 25% increase in participation for the NFAA December championship. Final decision: MBH will hold a separate NFAA sanctioned MBH state indoor championship on December 16th, 2012 using the same fee structure as 2011. ANY active MBH/NFAA club or MBH/NFAA Commercial Lane that meets course inspection requirements, may host the event. Applications to serve as a tournament site must be received by the 2012 State Outdoor tournament in July.

Budget for the MBH State Indoor in March

The MBH State Indoor will be held March 17 and 18th at Linn Technical College in Linn, Mo with a tournament budget not to exceed the amount spent for 2011. There will be no change in the entry fees for 2012.

4H State Shooting Sports Archery team in 2012

MBH will provide \$500 to help the 4H 2012 State Archery Shooting Sports team with their expenses for the 2012 national competition and allow the team members to shoot MBH tournaments for no cost. 4H state archery team members will not be eligible for awards if they participate at no cost.

Conservation Federation of Missouri

MBH to continue membership in the Conservation Federation of Missouri and pay \$270 dues for 2012. Jeff Blystone will represent MBH at the State convention and MBH will pay his expenses up to \$500.

NFAA Director for 2012/2013 term (2 years):

Kathy Potter was elected to serve as the NFAA Director for 2012 and 2013.


