

LARGE AND SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

Fall archery hunting season coming up its time to remind you of the Annual Large Game Awards Program. Just fill out a Large Game Form and sent it to me via the website or through the mail. The report can be found and filled out on our web site at www.mobowhunters.org or in this newsletter or give me a call and I can send you one. All MBH members are eligible to earn the Missouri Bowhunters Large Game Award pin when they turn in their first ever Large Game Report. Deer, turkey, & predators qualify as large game in the program. MBH annual awards for 2013/14 season will be;

1st Fall Turkey- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill.

1st Deer- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get more than one opening day kill.

Last Deer- again we usually get several reports near the end of season.

P&Y Typical Best Buck- Must have a copy of the score sheet from a qualified P&Y, B&C, or MABB scorer. Green score is acceptable. If you need help finding a qualified scorer, give me a call & I might be able to help.

P&Y Non-Typical Best Buck- same as above

Lucky Deer- At the start of the season an average field dressed weight is chosen at random by me. The member that harvests a deer at that weight or closest to it wins the Lucky Deer Award.

Grand Slam Award- If any MBH member fills their Archery Permit (2 deer & 2 Turkey) they will receive this award and one lucky Grand Slammer will be drawn to receive a \$25 BPS gift card.

There will be two bowfishing awards given this year. Since these are not available to enter on the web site just send it to me by mail or email or give me a call.

Big Fish Kill- biggest fish kill by weight (all legal species included).

Longest Gar Kill- measured in inches to the closest 1/4".

Winners will receive a certificate of achievement suitable for framing, a Bass Pro Shops \$25 gift card, and recognition in the MBH Release Newsletter.

Deadline for all entries will be March 1, 2014.

I hope this will encourage you to submit your game reports and pictures this year. We all love to see those pictures and I am sure you are proud of your accomplishment, as you should be.

Jim Brinkman won the 1st Fall Turkey and a Grand Slam Award last year.



CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

Many of you may be aware that Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD), an incurable and always fatal disease affecting members of the deer family (cervids) has been discovered in Missouri. Recently a Missouri House of Representatives Interim Committee was formed to study the cause and spread of the disease in order to seek legislative remedies. This CWD Interim Committee has scheduled a series of hearings on this extremely important subject. If left unchecked, this disease will have severe repercussions for our state and its deer herd. In states where CWD has been present for many years, a herd reduction of up to 45% has occurred and few bucks survive past 3½ years of age. Without question, it is imperative that we advocate for effective means to not only curtail the spread of this devastating disease but to seek a way to destroy its cause. At this website you will find several articles and the locations of about 40 high fence hunting preserves and another 224 wildlife breeding facilities. Each one of these is legally allowed buy, sell, ship, receive and confine live cervids such as deer and elk.

Below is a list of dates for upcoming CWD Interim Committee Hearings. Please make plans to attend one or more of these if possible and help us spread the word to others!

Monday, July 15 at 1:00PM-3:00PM State Capitol (Jefferson City) in HR 1. *Travis Scott of the Conservation Federation of Missouri summarized this meeting as follows; The MDC talked for about an hour to the state congressmen in attendance about the danger of CWD and the need for more regulation on game farms. The legislators then grilled them pretty hard with questions. Then the alliance of game farmers got their turn. They brought in a paid doctor of something (biology, I guess) from Texas who told the legislators that all was good, no harm can come from game farmed animals, etc., etc. What the good doctor didn't tell the legislators was that he was also a person who ran a high-fence game farm! While the game farm group of people is small, they have a lot of financial backing from across the U.S. and they are betting on two things:*

1) That their money will sway the opinions of those who matter and 2) That we, the sportsmen of Missouri, will be complacent and let the game ranchers have it their way. We need to show the powers that be that this will not be the case!

The spread of CWD in our state will have a tremendously negative impact on property values, seasonal tourism, and the quality of life of the more than half a million individuals who enjoy the annual fall deer hunting tradition.
