

Frog Season? You bet! Missouri's frog season opened at sunset on June 30th and runs through October 31st.

Frog hunt'in with your bow is a simple and fun activity during the summer months not to mention the good eatin that a mess of fried frog legs provides after the hunt. Shots are usually close and you can retrieve your arrows after the shot because the arrow buries into the pond bank instead of disappearing under the grass as it does when shooting at other small game like rabbits or groundhogs.

You will need a small game hunting permit to legally pursue frogs with your bow. Bullfrogs and Green frogs are legal species you can harvest and the daily limit is 8 frogs with a possession limit of 16. There are lots of small ponds on most MDC public areas you can hunt but be sure to

check each area's regulation's to make sure frog hunting is allowed.

By the way I did not receive any Spring Turkey Harvest Reports. So the award for the 1st Spring Turkey by an MBH member was not awarded for 2013. The deadline was June 15th so if you think you submitted a report before the deadline please give me a call.

15 to attend the Missouri Senior Games. weekends in a month to do it all.

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

It time to go on line at http://mdc. mo.gov/hunting-trapping/deerhunting/2013-2014-managed-hunts and apply for the special manage hunts that the Missouri department of Conservation conducts every year. The application period is July 1st through August 15th. You will be notified of the selection by September 14, 2013. It's a simple process and you may get an opportunity to hunt a antlerless deer only but there are great area. Even if you don't get drawn for one of the hunts this year you still earn preference points so that your chances are better for next years draw. You can also look up the 2012 Managed Deer Hunt Summaries. All of last year's hunts are listed with your chances of getting drawn for any particular hunt and what the hunter success rate was for all of the hunts. Last year there were 16 archery only hunts offered and another 29 hunts for archery or crossbows.

The Archery only hunts had an average success rate of 49%. That's pretty good odds and a lot of the hunts offer the opportunity to harvest a buck and multiple does. This year there is a new hunt that has been added at the **Ozark National Scenic Riverways** in the Big Spring Area of Carter County. It's a three day hunt for 80 spots to fill and when a new area opens it usually means great hunting and lots of deer so you may want to check that one out. It is also a good idea to take the Missouri Bowhunter Education Coarse if haven't done so already. Some of the Urban Hunts will require you to be Bowhunter Education Certified. You can find the locations and register for the classes at the following website link.

http://www.register-ed.com/ programs/missouri/12-missouribowhunter-education-classroomcourse.

Currently there are six classes listed throughout the state. It's also time to start shooting your bow in earnest to prepare for the upcoming season. One of the best ways to practice that I know of is to shoot 3D tournaments. One tourney you will want to attend for sure is the MBH State 3D Championship held this year in Carrollton. It will be a two day event on July 27^{th} & 28^{th} this year that is sure to challenge your archery skills.




