

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

A couple of years ago in the October 2011 Release I told you about a Missouri Black bear research project. The research part of that project has been completed and the biologists are working on their final report to be published. You can watch a short video at <http://mdc.mo.gov/media/video/black-bear-study-phase-2-hair-snares>, listen to what MDC biologist Jeff Beringer and Graduate Student Researcher Clay Wilton have to say about the DNA sampling they are doing. Here are some highlights from the research team.

- An overall population estimate of 252 bears in Missouri
- 61 different bears were captured 101 times – 36 males and 25 females.
- 53 bears were fitted with radio collars.
- Captured male bears weighed 42 to 485 pounds, while females weighed 70 to 220 pounds.
- Male home ranges averaged 127 square miles and female home ranges averaged a much smaller 40 square miles.
- Female bears dened in mid-November and males in early December. Males left dens in early March and females left in late March.
- Black bear distribution in southern Missouri appears patchy and restricted to areas of continuous forest such as the Mark Twain National Forest.
