The Shot of a Lifetime...a Gift from God





Tournament Changes

At the August B of R meeting, we discussed our charter with NFAA and what it means for not only the NFAA, but also for Missouri Bow Hunters.

One of the topics we discussed has to do with our tournaments and compliance with the NFAA Constitution and ByLaws, specifically addressing the use of "State" and "Championship" when referring to state level tournaments. It was decided that beginning in 2015, our State Indoor Championship held in March, will take the place of the 450 Round that currently takes place in November/December, and so the 450 will no longer happen after January, 2015. The State Field Championship, held in July will remain an MBH/NFAA tournament. The State 600 Championship, that began in 2013 will now be an MBH/NFAA tournament too. The MBH State 3D and the Youth Jamboree will continue as they do currently.

What this means to our members? In order to be eligibile for awards and/or prizes, you will need to be both an MBH member and an NFAA member for the "Championship" tournaments going forward. Since a large number of our

members already hold either an NFAA or USA Archery membership, you will not need to do anythings else. If you have questions or need clarification, please don't hesitate to reach out to the officers or to your BofR for more information.

Scholarship Changes - 2 Scholarships to be Given

At the August B of R meeting, we discussed the Paul Jeffries Scholarship, and how that should be awarded each year.

Previously, a scholarship of \$500 was presented to one young person to help with college fees and costs.

We also discussed how to raise funds to make sure the scholarship continues for many years to come, and we have some really great ideas we will be firming up in the near future.

It was also decided that, effective with the 2015 presentation, MBH will present a \$500 scholarship to one boy and one girl. There is a copy of the scholarship application included in the Release and online at http://mobowhunters.org.

A few of you are actually trying to do both! Whatever your passion, it's time to get busy and start enjoying some ARCHERY!

Most of you know that Missouri Bow Hunters holds the state charter for the National Field Archery Association. Among other things, state charter holders are required to hold 1 state indoor championship sanctioned by NFAA, every year. In order for it to be a sanctioned event, NFAA rules must be followed and participants must hold an active NFAA membership.

This year our NFAA Sanctioned State Indoor will be held at multiple locations across the state over a period of two weekends beginning November 28th and ending December 7th. The tournament consists of a single NFAA 450 round. Please see the flyer in this month's issue for registration information. We hope you will support MBH/NFAA and participate in this Indoor event!

For 2015, the MBH Board of Representatives has voted to revert back to a single Indoor State Championship that will

be held in March at Linn, MO. Both MBH and NFAA membership will be required in order to participate.

The NFAA National Indoor Championship will be March 14th and 15th, 2015 in Louisville, KY. Last year it was really difficult to find rooms. The other day, we took a chance and called the Hyatt, which is connected to the Convention Center. They already had a block of rooms available at the special archery event rate of \$109 per night. This is a really nice hotel and the best part is parking your vehicle for the weekend and being able to walk to anything you want to do. However... 

- 4. Charles Cashatt Jr, Excelsior Springs, Hen Turkey harvested on 9/26/14 on public ground in Clay Co. Made a 21 yard shot on the walking bird. #12 all time.
- 5. Kathy Brinkmann, Labadie, 60 lb. Doe, shot on 10/4/14 at 5:32pm in St. Charles Co.
- 6. Jim Brinkmann, Labadie, Tom Turkey, made a 30 yard shot on 10/7/14 at 9:00am in St Charles Co.
- 7. Jerry Decker, Lee's Summit, 170 lb. 10pt Buck, harvested at 6:50pm on 10/12/14. Killed in Jackson Co. This was the NFAA Grand Master Bow Hunter's 41st deer all time in 49 years of Bow Hunting!

Notice that I have left the harvest times out of Jeff Reddy's opening day deer kill and Charles Cashatt's turkey kill. They are in the running for the annual 1st deer and turkey harvest of the year. If you've killed an opening day deer or a turkey on or before 9/26/14 then you had better fill out a Large Game report to be considered for the awards.

Note; Whenever I receive a game report via the website or by US mail I will always respond to let you know I received your report. If you do not get a response from me then I probably didn't get the report so please resend it or give me a call or try to contact me at my email address.



Conservation Committee

Conservation Commission Takes Action To Protect Deer In Missouri

Public comments and dozens of public meetings showed overwhelming support for proposed regulations to prevent the spread of chronic wasting disease.

On October 17, 2014 the Conservation Commission unanimously voted to approve proposed amendments to regulations regarding the operation of hunting preserves and wildlife breeding facilities that hold white-tailed deer, mule deer, their hybrids, and other members of the deer family, known as cervids, to prevent the spread of diseases, including chronic wasting disease, to the state's deer herd.

Actions by the Commission include:

- Banning the importation of live white-tailed deer, mule deer, and their hybrids from other states. The regulation still allows for the importation of semen for artificial insemination.
- Requiring all facilities, existing and new, to maintain or construct a single 8-foot fence following specific standards detailed in the Wildlife Code of Missouri. Existing facilities would have 18 months to bring fencing into compliance.
- Requiring Class I and Class II wildlife breeders and big game hunting preserves to test all mortalities of deer that are older than six months for chronic wasting disease and allow permittees to apply for an exemption from mandatory testing requirements in the event of a mass-casualty event.

- Requiring Class I and Class II wildlife breeders that hold deer to participate in a United States Department of Agriculture-approved chronic wasting disease herd certification program.
- Set requirements for disease testing, record-keeping, reporting disease test results, and complying with an established disease response plan in the event a disease is discovered.
- Prohibiting any new captive-cervid facilities within 25 miles of a confirmed chronic wasting disease location for five years. The regulation changes will go into effect Jan. 30, 2015. "Chronic wasting disease is a neurological disease that affects members of the deer family and, with no known cure, it is 100 percent fatal," said MDC Deputy Director Tom Draper. "These amendments work to reduce the risk of chronic wasting disease spreading beyond the limited area where it has been found in northern Missouri to ensure the health of Missouri's entire deer herd, including free-ranging and captive-cervids."


