A Single Vote Does Count The Governor's Veto of Bill 506 was Upheld by One Vote

In a marathon veto session last night, the attempts of the Missouri House to override the Governor's veto of Senate Bill 506, failed by just one vote. Those of us concerned with protecting the health and well being of Missouri's deer herd, should now get some well deserved rest.

Don't ever tell yourself that one vote doesn't make a difference.

I commend each one of you for making those all important legislative contacts, communicating with the Governors office, and getting others to do the same. 109 votes in the House were required to override the bill, and there were only 108. Those Representatives wishing to punish the MDC, put at risk the annual one billion dollar economic boost that deer hunting provides, endanger the 12,000+ private sector jobs in Missouri, as well as jeopardize the health of Missouri's deer herd, were thwarted by one vote!

Congratulations, as you may have been the one who caused that to happen.

At this juncture, all of the incredible \$\$\$\$\$\$ spent by those wishing to take away the authority of the MDC in managing all deer or cervids in the state has gone for naught. Just think how that ton of expenses could have gone for some worthwhile program, like paying this years' Share The Harvest processing fees for all of the statewide deer donations ! The Governor has challenged us to donate OVER 10,000 deer. Let us celebrate this victory by doing just that!

There are a few exceptions to the adage that, "we have the best government money can buy," and the defeat of deer becoming livestock to avoid the MDC is a stand out example.

I thank each and every one of your for the energy you put into this all important and historic issue. The deer of the state cannot speak. Conservationist like you and me must continue to be their voice.

We are all indebted to the leadership of the Conservation Federation of Missouri who led the charge for all of the 500,000+ deer hunters and the millions of folks in Missouri that appreciate it's deer herd.



Captive Deer Regulations Remain With MDC

September 10, 2014 was a special day for the Conservation Federation of Missouri. It marked the 79th anniversary of the formation of our organization, and now also marks the day CFM helped end legislation that would have reclassified captive white-tailed deer from wildlife to livestock.

Senate Bill 506 was an agriculture omnibus bill that contained legislation to transfer control of captive deer from the Missouri Department of Conservation to the Missouri Department of Agriculture. The bill died yesterday when the House of Representatives fell one vote shy of the 109 they needed to override Governor Nixon's veto. The Senate vote to override passed by two votes.

CFM members put their heart and soul into ending this legislation and protecting wildlife. The power of motivated citizens working for a cause they believe in never ceases to amaze. We know white-tailed deer are wildlife. We know it doesn't matter what side of a fence they are on. We are grateful to the legislators who voted to end this senseless legislation.

The founding fathers of CFM must be mighty proud of us today. CFM members who came before us fought to protect and promote the natural resources of Missouri. Yesterday we left our mark with a win for this generation of conservationists.

On behalf of the Conservation Federation of Missouri and millions of Missouri wildlife enthusiasts, we thank the 52

state representatives for their commitment to sportsmen and the millions of Missourians who simply appreciate wildlife.

CFM understands the importance and believes in the strength of our state's agricultural industry. We believe agriculture and conservation must work together, and CFM is committed to helping further efforts to do so for the greater good of our state. Yet, the captive cervid language in SB 506 was damaging to those efforts. It should have never been added to the agriculture omnibus bill. A political maneuver to backdoor bad legislation backfired. Hopefully, the good legislation that suffered because of politics can be passed as stand alone bills during the next legislative session.

To the Representatives who made the difficult but correct choice to vote against SB 506, the conservation community of Missouri thanks you. We will not forget who our friends are.

A big thank you to everyone that fought to keep Missouri's Whitetail Deer "WILD"!

Large and Small Game Committee

Fall archery hunting season is here and it's time to remind you of the Annual Large Game Awards Program. Just fill out a Large Game Form and sent it to me via the website or through the mail. The report can be found and filled out on our web site at www.mobowhunters.org or in this newsletter or give me a call and I can send you one. All MBH members are eligible to earn the Missouri Bowhunters Large Game Award pin when they turn in their first ever Large Game Report. Deer, turkey, & predators qualify as large game in the program. MBH annual awards for 2014/15 season will be;

1st Fall Turkey- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill.

1st Deer- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get more than one opening day kill.

Last Deer- again we usually get several reports near the end of season.

P&Y Typical Best Buck- Must have a copy of the score sheet from a qualified P&Y, B&C, or MABB scorer. Green score is acceptable. If you need help finding a qualified scorer, give me a call & I might be able to help.

P&Y Non-Typical Best Buck- same as above

Lucky Deer- At the start of the season an average field dressed weight is chosen at random by me. The member that harvests a deer at that weight or closest to it wins the Lucky Deer Award.

Grand Slam Award- If any MBH member fills their Archery Permit (2 deer & 2 Turkey) they will receive this award and one lucky Grand Slammer will be drawn to receive a \$25 BPS gift card.

There will be two bowfishing awards given this year. Since these are not available to enter on the web site just send it to me by mail or email or give me a call.

Big Fish Kill- biggest fish kill by weight (all legal species included).


