LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE 2015 MBH Large Game Awards

This year's winners received a framed certificate and a \$25 Bass Pro Shops Gift Card.

1st Spring Turkey- *Winner –Don Witte, 4/20/15 @ 6:25am*

1st Fall Turkey- *Winner –Allen Boesch, Hen on 10/1/15 @ 5:10pm*

1st Deer- *Winner –Dan Jasa, Doe on 9/15/15 @5:45pm*

Last Deer- *Winner –Kathy Brinkmann, Doe on 1/15/16 @ 8:02am*

Lucky Deer- At the start of the season an average field dressed weight is chosen at random by me. The member that harvests a deer at that weight or closest to it wins the Lucky Deer Award. 2015 weight was 108 lb.

Winner –Charles Cashett Jr. = 109

Grand Slam Award- If any MBH member fills their Archery Permit (2 deer & 2 Turkey) they will receive this award. **Winners – Allen Boesch and Jim Brinkmann**

P&Y Typical Best Buck-*Winner –No Entry*

P&Y Non-Typical Best Buck- *Winner –No Entry*

Big Fish Kill- biggest fish kill by weight (all legal species included). **Winner –No Entry**

Longest Gar Kill- measured in inches to the closest 1/4". **Winner –No Entry**

Here is a summary of the large game reports turned in this year by MBH members.

DEER

35 deer reports total, 20 does, 10 bucks, & 5 button bucks.

12 members submitted harvest reports. One member topped the list with 7 deer harvested this past season.

Average shot distance was 18.22 yards; average distance to recovery was 54 yards.

32 deer were killed on private ground and 3 were taken on public ground.

21 deer were arrowed in the PM hours and 14 in the AM hours.

33 were taken from treestands and 2 were from a blind.

Carbon or Composite arrows were used in all of the kills, Mechanical Broadheads took 24 deer and fixed blade broadheads killed 11.

TURKEY

8 turkey reports total, 2 spring reports and 6 fall reports from 5 members.

Average shot distance was 15.6 yards; average distance to recovery was 6 yards.

All 8 birds were taken on private ground, 5 in the AM hours and 3 in the PM.

5 birds were killed using blinds, 2 from treestands, and 1 while stalking.

Carbon arrows were used in all kills, 6 kills were using mechanical broadheads and 2 used fixed blades.

I would like to give a little recognition to a few of the Missouri Bow Hunters Association members that turned in reports this past year. The youngest MBH member reporting success was 19 year old Bailey Smith with a January 13th turkey kill! The oldest member was Charlie Langreder at 76 years young; he harvested a doe on October 24th. I also had two 75 year old members, Allen Boesch and Vernie Broyles who had successful seasons. Finally I would like to give hearty congratulations to Jim & Kathy Brinkmann. Jim harvested 7 deer and 3 turkeys in 2015. Kathy wasn't far behind with 6 deer kills to her credit in 2015.

Time to say so long for now but remember spring turkey season is only a little over 6 weeks away so start practicing and remember to submit your spring turkey harvest via the MBH website at www.mobowhunters.org under the Game Awards tab.

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

There is a great tool available for free to anyone that is interested in keeping up with and evolving your opinion on Conservation items that are being proposed in the Missouri State Legislature. The Conservation Federation of Missouri has implemented the **Legislative Action Center** which is a Web based approach for citizens to voice opinions on pending state legislation impacting conservation, natural resources and outdoor recreation. You don't need to be a CFM member to sign up and use the tool. Simply visit the CFM website at <http://confedmo.org/> and click on



To sign up. Once you're signed up you will receive alerts informing you of legislation actions concerning conservation. The tool also lets you know who your state representative and senator are and how to contact them via phone or email. The site also will provide you with scientific data and facts, so you may participate as an informed citizen about how to best manage the natural resources of our state. You can vote for or against the pending legislation to let your representative know your position.

There are currently nine different pieces of legislation being discussed in Jefferson City as I write this article. Here's a short summary of each one. Followed by CFM's comments on the bill.

Cervid Legislation;

HB 1412: Specifies that the Department of Agriculture has the authority to regulate agricultural deer.

CFM remains adamant that white-tailed deer are wildlife, not livestock. Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) is making an impact on our state. The always fatal disease is spreading. The Missouri Department of Conservation needs to maintain control of white-tailed deer. The captive deer industry is spreading CWD by transporting deer by trailers to new locations, and that industry seemingly falls outside the concerns of the Department of Agriculture.

HB 1411: Allows for the slaughter and processing of captive cervids for human consumption at facilities inspected by the USDA or Department of Agriculture.

Captive cervids are pumped full of hormones and steroids by breeders to mutate nature and grow racks far exceeding what you will ever find in the wild. Many of the drugs administered to these cervids are not for human consumption. CFM opposes legislation that leads to an expansion of the captive cervid industry, thus putting Missouri's most sought after and economically important wildlife species, the white-tailed deer, at further risk.

Conservation Authority;

HB 1529: Requires the Department of Conservation to reimburse automobile owners up to \$500 for damage inflicted upon their vehicles by wildlife.

The Department of Conservation works hard everyday to ensure Missouri's natural resources are here for generations to come. Requiring the Department to pay for vehicle damages inflicted by wildlife would be a disservice to Missouri. This bill would take time and resources away from the important work the Department does every day.

SJR 19: Modifies the membership composition and terms of service the commissioners on the Conservation Commission.

When citizens created the Conservation Commission in 1936, they voted to have a four-member commission. This structure of the commission has worked for 80 years and continues to work today. The Conservation Commission needs to remain intact as a four member, bi-partisan commission. It would be a mistake to change the current composition of the Commission by increasing the membership to eight and requiring members to be appointed from each of the eight conservation regions. This would politicize the commission by creating constituencies for each commissioner. Infighting would surely occur over resource allocations. Commissioners should continue representing the entire state and work together to manage forest, fish and wildlife for all Missourians. Commissioners should not focus on specific regions.

Wildlife

HB 1374: Specifies that the Department of Conservation is liable for any damages caused by wild otter, elk, or bear.

The Missouri Department of Conservation is one of the best in the country. It holds the important job of preserving Missouri's precious natural resources. Making it liable for damages caused by wild otter, elk or bear would be a costly burden to put on the Department. It would interfere with their important work of keeping Missouri a top outdoor destination for the country.

HB 1971: Imposes civil penalties for poaching certain animals.

This bill increases the punishments for wildlife poaching in Missouri. It would create a \$750 fine for a wild turkey, \$1,500 fine for a whitetailed deer and \$3,500 for each elk or black bear poached. Poaching is an extremely disheartening crime against wildlife. Missouri's wildlife belong to the citizens and are meant to be enjoyed and learned from. Increasing the punishments for poaching will discourage these disgraceful acts.

Permit Sales

HB 1846: Changes the laws regarding resident landowner hunting permits.

House Bill 1846 changes who can hunt for free with resident landowner permits on private property. Currently, Missouri residents who own at least 5 continuous acres and his or her immediate household members age 6 or older qualify. So do any Missouri residents who lease and live on at least 5 continuous acres owned by others, and his or her immediate household members age 6 or older. And any Missouri resident who is a general partner of a partnership, an officer of a resident or foreign corporation, an officer or managing member of a resident limited liability company, or an officer of a benevolent association organized pursuant to Chapter 352 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri when the before mentioned organization owns at least 5 continuous acres. This bill would change those qualifications to allow any "immediate family member," including parent, sibling, child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a resident landowner or lessee, to hunt for free. This broad approach would eliminate significant revenue from the Department of Conservation.

Land Access

HB 1970: Allows all-terrain vehicles to be used by individuals sixty years of age or older on conservation land for the purposes of hunting or fishing.

The use of all-terrain vehicles by individuals 60+ years old on MDC land would negatively affect the enjoyment opportunities of others using such lands, especially those who are hunting. All-terrain vehicles are loud and spook game. MDC has special riding areas and certain individuals are eligible for special use permits. It is unfathomable to think of all-terrain vehicles being driven on conservation land while others look to recreate in the outdoors.

HB 2047: Allows certain individuals to use all terrain vehicles and golf carts on the Katy Trail on certain days.

The Katy Trail is a Missouri treasure that is designed for non-motorized traffic. It is recognized nationally as one of the greatest state parks in America. A large part of the appeal of the Katy Trail is that it is away from motorized traffic, away from noise, and safe. People visit the Katy from all over Missouri, from all 50 states, and from many foreign countries every year because it is a unique natural attraction. Allowing motor vehicles--with their noise, smell, and wide footprint on the trail, will make the trail less attractive to visitors. The Katy Trail brings \$18 million in economic development to trail communities annually. That economic impact is based on the fact that the trail is quiet, safe, natural, and free of motor vehicles.

Make sure to let your state legislators know how you feel about each one of these bills.
