### LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

I have received a few more deer reports.

- **3.** Jack Davis, Camdenton, killed a 107lb doe on the morning of October 11 in Morgan County. Jack made a 26 yard shot with his Hoyt 55lb compound bow & mechanical Rage broadhead. This is Jack's 67<sup>th</sup> all-time deer harvest with archery gear.
- 4. Quinn Talbott, Graham, used a 40lb longbow he built to harvest and 8 point buck on the morning of October 22 in Nodaway County. Quinn's buck field dressed at 130lbs and was only 10 yards from his tree stand when it was hit with the fixed 2 blade German Jager broadhead and aluminum Easton arrow. Deer number 12 in 22 years of bowhunting for Quinn.
- **5. Richard Noble,** Saint Charles, killed a 1611b. 8 point buck on the morning of 10/25/16 in Pike County with a 15 yard shot from his treestand. Killed with a 60lb. PSE compound, NAP/3 blade mechanical broadhead and composite arrows.
- 6. Jeff Reddy, Saint Charles, used his 63lb PSE compound to put some meat in the freezer on November 8<sup>th</sup>. The button buck field dressed at 65lbs and was killed from Jeff's treestand in St. Louis County at 18 yards. Deer harvest number 12 for Jeff.
- Jeff Blystone, Independence, killed an 85lb doe on 11/11/16 at 5:20pm. Jeff's used traditional archery gear to make the 15 yard shot in Hickory County. Black Widow 45lb recurve bow, Carbon Express arrows, and a Magnus 4 blade fixed broadhead did the job for Jeff's #2 traditional kill and #29 all time in 26 years of archery hunting.

Let's end this historical review with the year 2010 MBH deer and turkey reports.

In 2010 archery season ran from September 15 until January 15<sup>th</sup> (season was extended in 2004) your archery tag allowed you two deer and two turkey of either sex. You could harvest both deer before firearms season but only one could be antlered. You could also purchase unlimited antlerless archery deer permits for \$7 each in addition to the 2 deer your archery permit allowed. You could harvest more deer with archery tackle if you used your bow during the firearms season and tagged it with your firearms permits. There were over 170,000 individual archery hunters in 2010. The number of archery hunters includes the landowner archery permits which were not included in the previous summary articles. Archers had a deer harvest of 43,372 (*almost doubling the kill from just 10 years ago*) for a 24% success rate (*almost the same as 2000*). The archery harvest was 15.8% (*compared to 9.65% in 2000*) of the total deer harvest which was 273,534 deer in 2010.

So a summary of the 2010 archery season would be; bowhunters harvested twice as many deer with a success rate of over 20% while still only being about 15% of the total deer kill as compared to 2000.

Again let's compare the 2010 season to the 2014 season. The 2010 and 2014 seasons and limits were basically the same. There were 189,452 individuals who possessed archery permits in 2014 with a deer harvest of 48,449 for a 26% success rate. The archery harvest was 23% of the total deer harvest which was 206,640 deer in 2014. So in 2014 there were over **15,000 more** archery hunters, they killed **only 5,077** more deer, with a **less than 2%** increased success rate than in 2010.

There were only 19 different MBH members (*compared to 35 in 2000*) that turned in deer reports. 5 members (*compared to 8 in 2000*) turned in turkey harvest reports.

Four members filled 2 deer tags in 2010. Four members got 3 deer, and five members reported killing 4 deer.

Four MBH members were able to fill two turkey and two deer tags with their bows in 2010 to earn the "Grand Slam". David Druml of Centertown, Frank Toliver of Wheatland, Jim Brinkmann of Labadie and Don Witte of Rosebud. Only 1 member reported kills in 1980, 1990, 2000, and 2010. Frank Toliver of Wheatland was successful in each of the decade years we are talking about. Frank was 83 years old in 2010 and still filled 2 turkey and 2 deer tags. That's one reason Frank is in the Missouri Bow Hunters Association "Hall of Fame".

The average shot was about 19 yards. The average experience of MBH members was about 30 seasons.

I know that most of the MBH members are still hunting and a lot are harvesting deer but the trend seems to be the older MBH members are still reporting their kills but the younger folks just aren't into the paperwork I guess. You can submit reports simply by clicking a few choices via our website using the on line report but I guess membership doesn't feel the need anymore.

Here are some interesting facts about the MBH members' choice of archery tackle in 2010.

Compound Bows accounted for all but one of the kills. The top Compound Bow used was Mathews followed by newcomer Bowtech with PSE coming in third. Only 1 harvest was from a Traditional recurve.

The average bow draw weight dropped further to 58.5 pounds. Bows and arrows are still improving and becoming more efficient in delivering stored limb energy to the arrow thus reducing the need for heavier draw weights.

Carbon arrows are the new normal with 87% of the reports using carbon arrows. Easton and Beman brands are leading the field. Easton aluminum arrows were used on only 7 kills.

Fixed blade broadheads are still the most used but the mechanicals are gaining in popularity. Fixed blade broadheads were used 70% of the time. The top 3 fixed brands were Muzzy, Wasp, and NAP. The most popular mechanical head was a Vortex with 5 kills followed by Rage and NAP with 4 kills each.

38 game kills were documented from treestands, 15 from a blind, 4 still hunting, and 2 by stalking. Morning hunt kills lead with 36 and there were 23pm kills in 2010. Private land hunting was more successful in 2010 again as 86% of the kills were on private land and only 14% on public which was almost the same as in 2000. In 1980 that ratio was 63% private land compared to 37% public land.

The Missouri archery season statistics were found by searching the Missouri Department of Conservations website at <u>https://mdc.mo.gov/</u>. The 2010 MBH member's statistics were compiled from Missouri Bow Hunters Association large game reports that are currently in my possession. I would like to encourage MBH members to submit their large game harvests for the 2016 season so that the MBH historical record can continue. You can submit your reports by going to the MBH website at <u>http://mobowhunters.org/</u> and clicking on the Game Awards tab, then filling out the Large Game App and submitting it.

I will be listing the successful MBH members each month of the 2016 season in our monthly Release newsletter. You can also send me your reports and pictures at my email below. Hopefully by next month's newsletter I'll have some 2016 success stories, until then.
