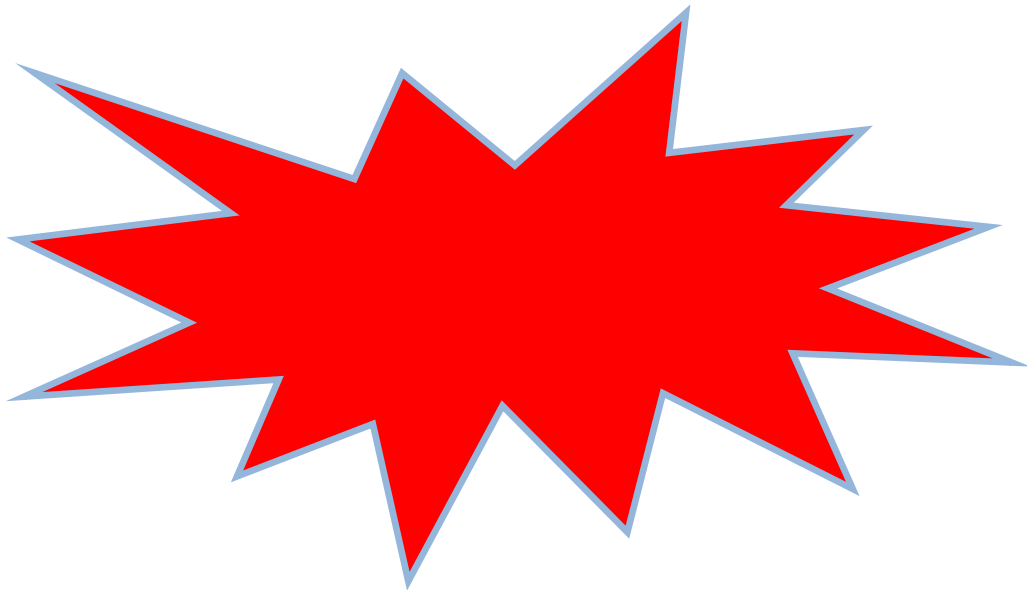

## 3-D EDIQUETTE—SOME THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The weather is getting better and you and your hunting buddies decide to go to the local 3D shoot to have some fun and brush up on your archery skills. Yes, 3D is not as “serious” as indoor competitive shooting, and according to 3D enthusiasts, it’s a lot more fun. But, there are some unadvertised protocols that you should know about when competing or even just shooting the course for fun.

When you go to a Pro-Am level 3D shoot, the rules are laid out very clearly and the extremely competitive archers are very serious about following them. But local 3D’s are put on by organizations to raise funds and offer a fun day of shooting foam. It’s a great idea, and hunters and competition shooters alike benefit from the practice. Here are a few unspoken rules that will help everyone have a great day.

Shooting groups should have no more than 6 shooters. The larger the group, the longer it takes at each target, so it tends clog up the course.

If there is a small group (2 people), having to wait behind your larger group, and there are empty targets in front of you; it is customary to have them *shoot through*. Allow them to shoot with (or before) your group for that target and then let them move on ahead of you.

Never discuss yardage out loud or before you shoot the target. (This is like someone scratching the chalkboard to serious 3D shooters). If you are not competing and want to *work it out* with your buddies, just whisper. Never discuss distance at all *before* you shoot a target if you are competing.

Step away from the stake after you have shot, so the next shooter can move to their stake right away. Do not stand at the stake and look with your binoculars at your arrow after you shoot it. (It’s not moving). You may however take time to look for the scoring ring on the animal before you shoot your arrow. That’s why we carry the binoculars.

If you are shooting with a group that uses different stakes (distances), have the person shooting from the furthest away from the target go first, then the next, and so on, having the person that shoots the closest (usually the kids) always shoot last. This saves time and will save you lots of steps. If you all shoot from the same stake, form a rotation, but don’t get hung up on it, because sometimes it’s just hard to remember who went first last.

Before you start shooting for the day, ask at the registration desk how they are scoring. Center 12’s or lower 12’s. They will explain the scoring rings to you if you have never shot before. If you are not scoring, but just shooting for fun; a good “vitals” shot will be great!

This last one should be a given, but it must be said. Watch your language while on the course. This is a family sport.

If you are alone or with one or two people, partner up with someone else that is there alone. You’ll meet some of the nicest people!
