



MDC seeking public comments on regulations as part of state review

Comment on MDC regulations online at <u>mdc.mo.gov</u> under EXISTING REGULATIONS.

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo. -- In accordance with Gov. Eric Greitens' executive order issued in January (<u>sos.mo.gov/library/reference/orders/2017/eo3</u>), the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) is undergoing a thorough review of and seeking public comment on all regulations of the Wildlife Code of Missouri under the Missouri Code of State Regulations.

Individuals can comment on MDC regulations online at <u>mdc.mo.gov</u> under EXISTING REGULATIONS (<u>short.mdc.mo.gov/Zia</u>).

"Citizen involvement and participation have always been important to the Missouri Department of Conservation," said MDC Director Sara Parker Pauley. "We value public input and want to hear from you."

MDC will also hold the following open houses from 6 – 8 p.m. to gather public feedback:

Back in 1999 when the first MBH Youth Bowfishing Tourney was held I'm sure Brothers Allen and Kent Hayes never dreamed they would still be doing this almost 20 years later. Hawaiian shirt attired Kent and Allen along with Kent's wife Sandy and Allen's son Ethan all said it was something they still look forward to all year long. They all agreed that it takes a lot of work and help from several volunteers and sponsor's to make this event happen every year. "The smiles on the kids' faces make it all worthwhile" says Allen. "Yep, this is what it's all about for me" said Kent after seeing his 13 year old granddaughter Kaidence posing with her fish of the day. This year's tourney happened on July 8th at Bledsoe Ferry below Truman Lake Dam and was completely free to all youth 16 and younger. Top three by fish weight in each division were awarded trophies. If no fish were shot, winners were drawn from a hat.

It was hot as usual but 43 young archers had a great time and each one of them walked away with great memories of a day outdoors and several gifts and door prizes, as well as a cookout all free of charge from the generous folks and businesses that sponsored the shoot. A big thank you goes to BowfishingExtreme .com, Batson Archery, Bass Pro Shops, AMS Bowfishing, AFFC Fin-Finder Bowfishing, Muzzy Bowfishing, and Missouri Bow Hunters Association for several door prize donations including Bows, reels, arrows, hats, stickers, trophies & T-Shirts. Every kid that signed up for the shoot got a T-Shirt, a grab bag of stuff, a fidget spinner, 2 fish arrows, and a hat. We also need to recognize the boat captains. It takes a kind of specialized boat set up with a raised platform to successfully arrow fish. These boat captains and guides donated their equipment and time to help get kids on the water and we could not have this event without them. I heard lots of excited kids talking about the ones that got away, great shots and misses, along with lots of I can't wait until next year. The fish that were harvested during the tournament were not wasted; they were donated to the "Turtle Man". The fish were used to feed endangered Alligator Snapping turtles and Common Snapping turtles that this local breeds and raises for conservation efforts in zoos and the pet trade.

2017–2018 Deer and Turkey Seasons

Archery Deer and Turkey Sept. 15-Nov. 10, 2017; Nov. 22, 2017-Jan. 15, 2018.

Firearms Turkey Oct. 1–31, 2017.

Firearms Deer Early Youth Portion Oct. 28–29, 2017.

Firearms Deer November Portion Nov. 11–21, 2017.

What's New for 2017?

• Hunters may take only two antlered deer during the archery and firearms deer season combined. This rule has not changed from last year. However, youth hunters may now take their second antlered deer during the early youth portion of firearms season. Previously, youth hunters had to wait until the November portion to harvest a second antlered deer. See Page 5.

- New counties have been added to the Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) Management Zone. See Page 7.
- During Nov. 11–12, hunters who harvest a deer in certain counties of the CWD Management Zone must take their deer on the day of harvest to a designated CWD sampling station. See Page 6.
- The antler-point restriction has been removed from Benton, Cedar, Hickory, and St. Clair counties. See Page 14.
- Hunters may now use firearms antlerless permits in Bollinger County. See Page 19.
- Hunters may now fill two firearms antlerless permits in Barry, Benton, Cedar, Dade, Hickory, Ozark, Polk, St. Clair, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve, Stone, and Taney counties. See Page 19.
- Qualifying landowners in Barry, Dade, Ozark, Polk, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve, Stone, and Taney counties may now receive two no-cost firearms antlerless permits. See Page 21.
- Barry, Dade, Ozark, Polk, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve, Stone, and Taney counties are now open during the antlerless portion of firearms deer season. See Page 29.
- New managed deer hunts have been added and others have been removed or modified. See pages 32–39.
- Deer hunting regulations have changed for some conservation areas. See pages 40–53.

Most of the changes are due to the expanding CWD management zones. MDC is trying to slow the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease in Missouri.
