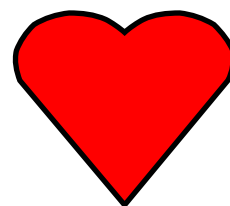
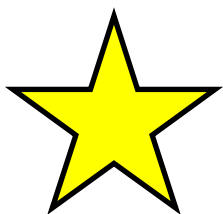
MBH has 36 bales for sale after the tournament is over.

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

With the close of the archery season, preliminary data from Missouri Department of Conservation showed that hunters checked 47,550 deer during the archery season. Top counties for the archery season were Jefferson with 1,118 deer harvested, Wayne with 980, St. Louis with 979, Franklin with 898, and Howell with 825. Archery hunters checked 49,759 deer the previous year so we are down over 4% this year. The total deer kill for all seasons was 263,832 for 2016 season also down about 3.5% from last year.

Fall archery turkey hunting also ended Jan. 15. Preliminary data from MDC showed 2,304 turkeys harvested. Top counties for the fall archery turkey season were St. Clair with 57 birds harvested, Franklin with 51, and Greene with 50. For the previous year, hunters harvested 3,042 turkeys. This year's number is down over 24% from last year.

The past season was the first in which MDC began allowing crossbows as a legal method during all the of archery season. Of the 47,550 deer harvested under archery methods, 14,336 were with crossbows. Of the 2,304 turkeys harvested under archery methods, 853 were with crossbows. That means 31.7% of the deer killed during archery season were killed with a crossbow. 37% of the archery season turkey kill happened with a crossbow. That seems like kind of a high percentage to me but the MDC hasn't published the number of Archery permits sold last year so I cannot determine an overall success rate or see if archery hunter permit sales were up significantly with the allowance of crossbows in 2016.

I also keep statistics on my archery season. I took to the field with my bow in hand 36 times and spent a total of 77 hours on stand. I saw a total of 54 deer and 11 turkeys during those 77 hours. I only harvested 1 doe but I also missed a doe at 15 yards and had a couple of close calls with good bucks but couldn't get a shot. Overall I consider my season a success but I saw fewer deer and turkeys than the last 3 seasons. Part of the reason for that was I lost one of my prime locations to hunt but that happens to all of us. I only hunted public land a couple of times but I did not see anyone using a crossbow so the crossbow regulation did not personally affect me that I could tell anyway. There will be more analysis and data to be studied over the next several months so stay tuned.

Missouri youth turkey season opens April 9 & 10th. Spring Turkey season is April 19th thru May 8th, 2017.

LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

The Brinkmann's have sent in their annual tally. Jim and Kathy hunt hard and harvest lots of game they share with family and friends. Congratulations to you both!

Jim Brinkmann, Labadie, harvested 5 does, a button buck, an 8 point buck, and a 9 point buck! He also filled both of his archery turkey tags and arrowed a coyote. I would say that's a great season. Jim used his Elite compound bow set at 58 lbs. draw weight, composite arrows and Swhacker mechanical broadheads for all of his kills this year. Jim's kill list is;

The season over, it is January 23rd as I'm writing this and I have not gotten very many harvest reports. Remember if you want a chance at any of the annual large game awards you must have your report turned in by February 15, 2017. Winners will receive a certificate of achievement suitable for framing, a Bass Pro Shops \$25 gift card, and recognition in the MBH Release Newsletter. The report can be found and filled out on our web site at www.mobowhunters.org under the Game Awards tab. All MBH members are eligible to earn the Missouri Bowhunters Large Game Award pin when they turn in their first ever Large Game Report. Deer, turkey, & predators qualify as large game in the program. Game killed with a crossbow is not eligible unless the MBH member has a handicap exemption.

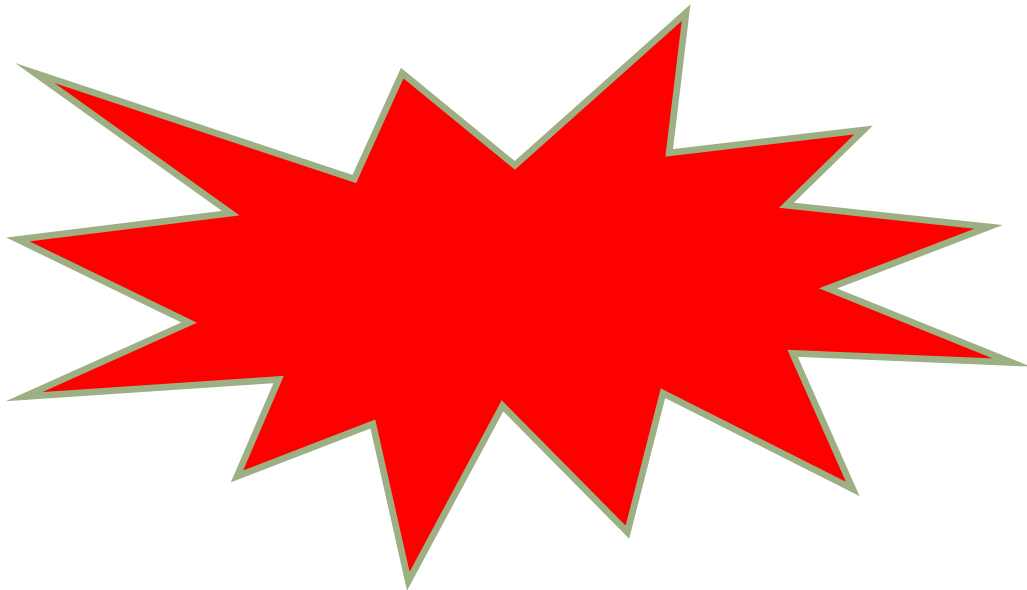
