

Field Archery for Beginners

If you talk to any old-time archer they will tell you field archery was very popular in Missouri around 40 years ago. Field archery is a discipline where archers shoot at known distances at a bullseye and animal target faces. Ranges are typically in a wooded area and have a variety of slope and terrain. Field Archery is divided into three different rounds: Field, Hunter and Animal. The field round has archers shoot distances from 20 feet up to 80 yards. The hunter round mixes a variety of odd number distances from 11 to 70 yards. The animal round is shot from 13 to 59 yards.

In the field and hunter rounds, archers shoot four arrows at each target. The maximum value per arrow is 5 points or 20 points per target. Only one arrow is shot in the animal round (provided it hits a scoring area). The animal target has a vital area (20 points) and a non-vital area (18 points). Full field tournaments will consist of 28 field targets, 28 hunter targets and 28 animal targets. State level and local tournaments will typically be less total targets. The Springfield field shoots for 2017 will be one day (14 field/14 hunter/14 animal).

Juniors (15-17 years of age) and adults shooting compound and recurve bows shoot the full distance out to 80 yards. Youth (12-14 years of age) and traditional equipment users shoot a maximum distance of 50 yards. Cubs (under 12 years old) shoot a maximum of 30 yards.

The Springfield Archery Complex offers a 14 target field range. The complex is open Monday-Friday from 12:00-7:00 and Saturdays 10:00-1:00. Archery staff members will offer a guided field shooting lesson to anyone just getting started. If an archer is not comfortable with the longer distances they can shoot a novice round with a 30 or 50 yard maximum distance.

Field archery is an opportunity for families to shoot together. Many 3D shooters are now shooting known classes. Field archery is a good opportunity for hunters and 3D shooters to practice a variety of distances. It usually takes two hours or less to shoot 14 targets (56 arrows). If you are in Springfield check out the field range or visit a range near you.

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

There were 22 different pieces of legislation introduced in Jefferson City in January of this year. Several of them have not gotten very far but some have made their way through committees and may come up from a vote in the legislature. Here's a short summary of some of the bills that may get voted on and have the biggest impact on Missouri's natural resources. I'll also include the Conservation Federation of Missouri's stance and comments about those pieces of legislation.

Cervid Legislation;

SB 123: Modifies provisions relating to captive cervids, sponsored by Senator Munzlinger from Monticello, Missouri. This bill's status is listed as; Formal Calendar S Bills for Perfection--SB 123-Munzlinger

[Last Updated: February 20, 2017] OPPOSE; The Conservation Federation of Missouri remains opposed redefining all captive cervids as livestock, and legalizing the sale of meat from captive cervids raised and slaughtered for that purpose. Redefining the species shifts regulatory authority from the Missouri Department of Conservation to the Missouri Department of Agriculture, damaging the ability to resist the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) in Missouri. Adding new revenue streams to the captive cervid industry increases the incentive to surround more Missouri land with game-proof fencing and convert it to confined cervid production, expanding the risk of more CWD outbreaks. It also adds venison raised in a CWD positive state to the commercial human food chain. Detailed information on the health risks of CWD can be found at NoMOcwd.org/health. The Captive Cervid bills are filed in support of the industry's national agenda to manipulate the courts and legislature to shift regulatory authority from wildlife agencies to agricultural agencies. Nothing in the mission, training or funding of an Agriculture agency has anything to do with protecting wildlife from disease. Their mission is to facilitate commerce in agricultural products.

Conservation Authority;

HJR 4: Proposes a constitutional amendment to assert the right of Missourians to hunt and fish, sponsored by Representative McGaugh from Carrollton. This bill's status is listed as; Read Second Time (H)[Last Updated: January 5, 2017] OPPOSE; Motivated by concerns that hunting and fishing could be impinged upon by a wide array of conflicting interests, 21 states have enacted some variation of this idea over the past twenty years, including Vermont which dates back to 1777. While this HJR seems innocuous, if passed by a vote of the people, it could set the stage for many potential challenges in the courts regarding where individual rights begin and end versus the authority of the Conservation Commission to determine methods, limits, seasons, and other restrictions (e.g., termination of privileges for violations). Moreover, the language of this HJR as written contains terms and concepts that are vague and lend themselves easily to legal questioning and challenges. Furthermore, it could be argued that existing constitutional governing the Conservation Commission implies some legal protection to hunting (and fishing) as accepted activities. HJR 25: Repels the Conservation Commission's authority to acquire land, sponsored by Representative Ross from Yukon, Missouri. This bill's status is listed as; Read Second Time (H) [Last Updated: January 12, 2017] OPPOSE; The Conservation Federation of Missouri is opposed to this bill that seeks to amend the Constitution and repeal Missouri Department of Conservation Commission's authority to acquire land. We have the best conservation department in the United States because Missouri citizens realize the value of our state's natural resources. The public has affirmed confidence in MDC through the voting process. The citizens of Missouri have given Missouri Department of Conservation not only the authority but the confidence to wisely improve our Fish, Forest and Wildlife in many ways and sometimes that is through land acquisition. Private citizens often wish to carry on a legacy which benefits the state's natural resources through the donation of their land. Waterways;

<u>HB 556:</u> Codifies provisions relating to the navigability of Missouri waters, sponsored by Representative Ross from Yukon, Missouri. This bills status is listed as; Read Second Time (H) [Last Updated: January 11, 2017]

OPPOSE: Much of this bill simply codifies existing case law. It appears that certain provisions of the bill could affect recreational use of Missouri streams by people who use waterways for floating and wading. It is unclear what streams, if any, would be impacted. Current Missouri law has been interpreted such that the public right to navigation extends to recreational boating in Missouri and all persons have a right to navigate any river or stream that has a sufficient flow to float a recreational boat like a canoe. There is no similar wording in this bill. Text in this bill specifies that "no adjoining parts of a watercourse are to be considered navigable unless they are deemed navigable by a Missouri Court". It also "Prohibits the Department of Natural Resources from implementing any portion of the federal rule to revise or provide guidance on the definition of "Waters of the United States" or "Navigable waters" under the Clean Water Act and specifies that "no federal agency may make a determination or designate any watercourse within the state as navigable". Wildlife;

HB 250 & 282; SB 241: These bills all have to do with increasing fines for poaching wild turkey, whitetail deer, elk, and black bear. They are sponsored by Representatives Taylor & Anderson from Nixa & Springfield also Senator Schatz from Sullivan. These bills' statuses are listed as; still in committee or public hearing. SUPPORT: CFM supports increasing penalties for poaching violations. Poaching has been and continues to be a serious problem across all regions of Missouri. Currently fines for poaching crimes are not sufficient. This bill increases penalties by creating restitution fines of: \$750 for each wild turkey; \$2000 for each white-tailed deer; \$5000 for each black bear or elk. Currently, any person pursuing, taking, killing, possessing, or disposing of wildlife illegally is guilty of a misdemeanor. Under this act, any person convicted of chasing, pursuing, taking, transporting, killing, processing, or disposing of a turkey, white-tailed deer, black bear, or elk illegally may also be required to provide restitution to the state as set forth in this act. General;

<u>HJR 9 & 38; SJR 16:</u> These bills all have to do with the 1/8 of 1% Conservation Sales Tax. All three bills propose that the renewal of this tax be approved by voters every six to 10 years. They are sponsored by Representatives Moon & Houghton from Ash Grove & Martinsburg and by Senator Munzlinger from Monticello. These bills' statuses are listed as; second reading or referred to committee.

OPPOSE: The Conservation Federation of Missouri strongly opposes this bill. Conservation does not last ten years. Conservation is never-ending. We must continue to fund conservation to ensure the future of our forest, fish and wildlife resources. The Conservation Sales Tax provides financial ability for the Conservation Commission to control, manage, restore, conserve and regulate the bird, fish, game, forestry and wildlife resources of the state, including the purchase or other acquisition of property for said purposes, and for the administration of the laws. To sign up. Once you're signed up you will receive alerts informing you of legislation actions concerning conservation. The tool also lets you know who your state representative and senator are and how to contact them via phone or email. The site also will provide you with scientific data and facts, so you may participate as an informed citizen about how to best manage the natural resources of our state. You can vote for or against the pending legislation to let you representative know your position. Make sure to let




