The ballots have to be postmarked by December 31, 2018 in order to be valid. Any questions please let me know.







CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Update on Senate Bill 627 which I wrote about last month— On June 1, then-Gov. Eric Greitens signed Senate Bill 627 into law — which the Senate passed March 8 and the House approved May 17 — that amends certain definitions in the meat inspection statute to include "captive cervids" alongside livestock and poultry. On August 28th the News Tribune reported Cole County Circuit Judge Jon Beetem has approved a temporary restraining order to keep a new state law dealing with meat inspection from going into effect Tuesday. Beetem noted his order makes "no determination as to the validity and/or constitutionality" of the new sections of state law challenged by the lawsuit. His order blocks the enforcement of only some of the new provisions, while allowing the rest of the new law to go into effect Tuesday September 4th.

On Friday October 5th the News Tribune reported Cole County Circuit Judge Jon Beetem has continued a temporary restraining order to keep a new state law dealing with meat inspection from going into effect. Beetem said the restraining order would stay in place until he decides whether to make the injunction permanent. Beetem's decision was announced following a hearing held on Thursday in which attorney James Kent Lowry, arguing for the Conservation Commission, said the new law conflicts with the commission's constitutional authority over wildlife. The commission also believes it doesn't take into account potential public health risks such as exposure and spreading of chronic wasting disease. You can read the full article at

you with your deer, turkey or predator. Only one large game form entry and one bonus entry per MBH member. Drawing will be held at the MBH State Indoor Tournament in of March of 2019. Deadline for entries is February 15, 2019. Game killed with a crossbow is not eligible unless the MBH member has a handicap exemption.

MBH will also recognize annual awards for 2018 season in the following categories;

1st Fall Turkey- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill.

1st Deer- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get more than one opening day kill.

<u>Last Deer</u>- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get several reports near the end of season.

<u>P&Y Typical Best Buck</u>- Must have a copy of the score sheet from a qualified P&Y, B&C, or MABB scorer. Green score is acceptable. If you need help finding a qualified scorer, give me a call & I might be able to help.

P&Y Non-Typical Best Buck- same as above

<u>Lucky Deer</u>- At the start of the season an average field dressed weight is chosen at random by me. The member that harvests a deer at that weight or closest to it wins the Lucky Deer Award.

<u>Grand Slam Award</u>- If any MBH member fills their Archery Permit (2 deer & 2 Turkey) they will receive this award. Winners of individual categories will receive a certificate of achievement suitable for framing and recognition in the MBH Release Newsletter. Deadline for all entries will be February 15, 2019.
