CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

In July the Missouri Supreme Court finally ruled on the long standing legal battle concerning the authority of the Missouri Conservation Commission over pen raised deer and facilities that breed them. Below is a statement from Missouri Hunters for Fair Chase as well as the link to the Missouri Supreme Court's full opinion.

Missouri Hunters for Fair Chase

July 7 at 3:27 PM ·

The myth that a fence turns deer into livestock has been cleanly dispatched by one precise and final shot from the bench!

The Supreme Court unanimously overturned the ruling of a circuit court judge who, in 2015, blocked urgently needed disease related regulations. It has taken over three years, but the regulations are reinstated.

The broad and sweeping language of the Supreme Court ruling went beyond overturning the circuit court. They made clear that wildlife and game are terms which define species. And that a wild species behind a fence is still wildlife. The constitutional authority granted to the Conservation Commission to manage wildlife now clearly includes all cervids in the state.

This should end the annual legislative effort to shift regulatory authority over penned cervids from the MDC to the MO Dept. of Agriculture. The industry is now regulated by the one agency responsible to look out for the public interest in healthy wildlife.

Chronic Wasting Disease, which poses a serious long-term threat to the viability of wild cervids, will now be managed with one less obstacle. It is still a complex and expensive job, but the MDC is now free to apply the controls necessary to limit industry related spread of CWD.

You will probably see and hear complaints from those who believe the court has taken away a farmers right to farm deer. They will say that the Missouri Department of Conservation is putting them out of business but that's not true. Those deer farmers can still raise deer and sell canned pen raised deer hunts to folks who like to shoot captive critters they just have to build better fences, test more often for disease, and they cannot import or export any deer across Missouri State lines. The people that are willing to pay to shoot deer inside a pen will just have to pay a little more for that now and the new regulation will help to slow down the spread of CWD in the unpenned free ranging whitetail deer population in Missouri.

MBH ANNUAL LARGE GAME AWARDS PROGRAM GRAND PRIZE IS A YETI 45qt COOLER!



This year the Annual MBH Large Game Awards Program will again have a **GRAND PRIZE DRAWING!** Just fill out a Large Game Form and send it to me via the MBH website. The report form will be your entry into the grand prize drawing. The report can be found and filled out on our web site at www.mobowhunters.org under the Game Awards tab. You must be an MBH member to be eligible for the drawing and to earn the Missouri Bowhunters Large Game Award pin. Deer, turkey, & predators qualify as large game in the program. Earn a **BONUS ENTRY** by sending me a picture of you with your deer, turkey or predator. Only one large game form entry and one bonus entry per MBH member. Drawing will be held at the MBH State Indoor Tournament in of March of 2019. Deadline for entries is February 15, 2019. Game killed with a crossbow is not eligible unless the MBH member has a handicap exemption.

MBH will also recognize annual awards for 2018 season in the following categories;

1st Fall Turkey- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill.

1st Deer- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get more than one opening day kill.

Last Deer- Be sure to record the date & time of the kill, we usually get several reports near the end of season.

P&Y Typical Best Buck- Must have a copy of the score sheet from a qualified P&Y, B&C, or MABB scorer. Green score is acceptable. If you need help finding a qualified scorer, give me a call & I might be able to help.

P&Y Non-Typical Best Buck- same as above

Lucky Deer- At the start of the season an average field dressed weight is chosen at random by me. The member that harvests a deer at that weight or closest to it wins the Lucky Deer Award.

Grand Slam Award- If any MBH member fills their Archery Permit (2 deer & 2 Turkey) they will receive this award. Winners of individual categories will receive a certificate of achievement suitable for framing and recognition in the MBH Release Newsletter. Deadline for all entries will be February 15, 2019.

Did you know?

MBH is a member club of NFAA (National Field Archery Association). If you have ever competed at an MBH State Tournament you probably know that you need to be a member of NFAA. Besides Sanctioning Tournaments at State and National Levels, the NFAA offers awards to Hunters. Below is the information from their website about the Art Young Awards. It could take a lifetime to earn the Grandmaster Bowhunter Status, and very few have done so. If you want more info, check out the NFAA website link on the MBH Webpage.

Art Young Awards:

The Art Young program offers a variety of Big Game and Small Game awards for NFAA Bowhunters. The purpose of the Art Young awards is to promote interest in bowhunting, to encourage good sportsmanship and to give recognition by the organized field archers to their members who obtain game with the bow.

An Art Young Big Game pin and a NFAA Big Game patch shall be given for the first example of each species taken with a bow and arrow. The Art Young Small Game Arrowhead Pin shall be given upon taking the first six species of small game. An Art Young Small Game patch shall be available. For each additional four species taken by a member an additional award in the form of a bar with the number four shall be presented to the hunter. There shall be no limit to the number of bars, which may be earned.

Bowhunter pins are earned based on the number of Big Game and Small Game awards received. The four levels of Bowhunter are Bowhunter Pin, Expert Bowhunter Pin, Master Bowhunter Pin and Grand Master Pin.
