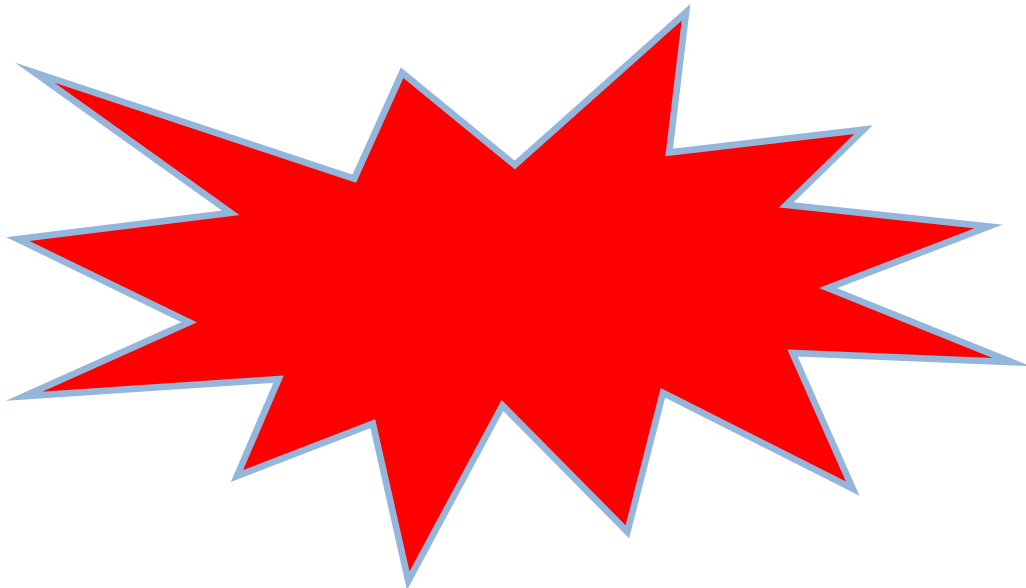

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

This month I want to talk about our obligation to become proficient with our choice of archery gear. Whether you have a top of the line compound bow with all the bells and whistles attached or just keep it simple and shoot a longbow you need to be able to hit what you're shooting at to insure a quick and clean kill of the game animal you're hunting. Yes I'm going to say it's an **obligation**. The definition of the word *obligation* is; *an act or course of action to which a person is morally or legally bound; a duty or commitment*. Although we are not legally bound to become good shots with our bows we are defiantly morally bound in my opinion. We as archers are not perfect and if you hunt with a bow and arrow long enough you will miss and unfortunately make a poor shot and wound an animal. I have done both and let me tell you there is nothing that makes me feel worse than the wounding of an animal because I screwed up! There are lots of factors that play into taking a shot at an animal with your bow, shot distance, shot angle, sunlight, shadows, and how alert the animal is. We must be able to evaluate those variables and only shoot when we are sure we can make the shot. The best practice I know of to help us be the best we can be is 3D archery shooting. I recently attended the Nadaho Bow Hunters Mother's Day shoot in Graham, MO. On May 13th. Nadaho Bow Hunters has long been and continues to be a strong MBH Club. This was only the second time I have shot one of their 3D's but I really enjoyed both times. The range set up great with 40 great targets, safe backstops, and nice mowed walking trails made the day lots of fun. The course is challenging but not too difficult so that new and old archers can have fun and hit their target. I saw some familiar faces that day and met some new folks. Club President Cody Sisk and Secretary Jeanette Brookshier had everything organized and running smoothly with volunteer help from Bill Brookshier, Quinn Talbott, Birdbird and Jenell Ciak as well as others from the club. They had 68 shooters that day. I shot the second half of the course with Bill Brookshier, Cody Sisk, Rick Horn, and a young man named Wyatt Wakely who was shooting his first 3D. Remember practice makes perfect so get out there forfull you obligation to become the best bowhunter you can be! Here are some photos and the results from Nadaho Bow Hunters Mother's Day 3D.

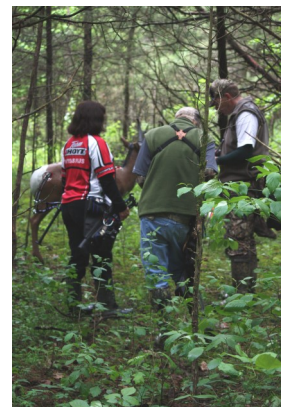

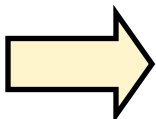

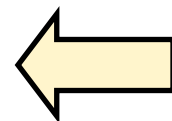
