



CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Since our founding in September of 1947 by leaders like Paul Jefferies and Earl Hoyt the Missouri Bow Hunters Association has been working to promote archery and the sport of bowhunting in Missouri. For over past 70 years now MBH has worked for the Missouri Bow Hunter. We have been involved with the Missouri Department of Conservation & the Conservation Federation of Missouri to establish seasons, limits, and provided volumes of data to help manage our great outdoor resources. Conservation is defined as the wise use of a resource. So the next time you are deciding if the Missouri Bow Hunters is an organization you want to belong to, just remember where we started and how far we've come. In November of 1946 Missouri had its first archery season that season was two days long; the license cost was \$3.15 which allowed you to take 1 buck plus they were competing with the gun hunters who were hunting the same season.

In 2018 a resident archery tag costs \$17, you could harvest 2 deer and 2 turkeys of either sex, and the archery only season lasts 4 months. There were 50 different manage deer hunts you could apply for plus lots of Urban deer hunts allowed for archery only hunters. Last year there were about 200,000 archery hunters and we harvested over 50,000 deer. While it's true that we have earned our place in Missouri's archery and deer hunting history it is also true that there are people and organizations that would like to limit or take away our hunting privileges. Deer hunting is also facing several other important challenges like Chronic Wasting Disease, poaching, and the impact of Crossbow hunters are having on the archery season. The annual cost of being an MBH member is \$25 for a single or \$30 for a family. A three pack of broadheads costs more than that. Frankly membership to the Missouri Bow Hunters Association is down and continues to decline. If you enjoy archery hunting you really should consider joining MBH. This organization is only as strong as its membership. Without a robust MBH membership our voice will not carry much weight with the policy makers at the Missouri Department of Conservation or any other policy maker that may have anti archery hunting motives in mind.

Each year I attend several MDC meetings and I am on the Board of Directors as your Affiliate Representative to the Conservation Federation of Missouri (CFM). CFM is the #1 citizen lead conservation organization in the state of Missouri.

MBH pays membership dues to CFM as an affiliate organization of CFM. Along with 90 other affiliate organizations that range from bird watchers to trappers to trout fishers to gardeners to canoeist. You can find out more about the Missouri Bow Hunters Association and join at www.mobowhunters.org

Youth Tournament Rules

- 1. Registration starts at 7:00 AM. Rules will be read at 7:45AM.
- 2. Tournament starts at 8:00AM and ends at 2:00PM. Weigh in will be at 3:00PM.
- 3. This is a 5-Fish tournament. A total of 5 fish may be checked in for heavy stringer.
- 4. All tournament fish will be disposed of for you.
- 5. Official Boundaries are Truman Lake & Lake of the Ozarks.
- 6. There will be three (3) divisions as follows:
 - A. 10 Years old and younger.
 - B. 11 years old to 13 years old.
 - C. 14 years old to 16 years old.
- 7. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be awarded in each age group.
- 8. Guides can help land fish. However, adults will not be allowed to use bows during this tournament. Any aid in landing a fish must come from another youth backing up the shot or using a dip net or gaff hook by an adult.
- 9. Life jackets must be worn always while the big motor is running.
- 10. Each youth will need to provide his/her own shooting equipment, if a boat is needed we will need to know 2 weeks in advance.
- 11. There will be numerous door prizes for all the kids.
