

LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

It's late July as I write this and I'm thinking of the upcoming archery season, although I was unsuccessful in drawing any Wyoming tags this year for Elk or Antelope I'm still hopeful I'll draw a Missouri Managed Hunt Tag. Even if I don't draw any of those "special" tags we are very lucky to live in a state where archery hunting opportunities are abundant and bag limits are liberal. My resident Missouri Archery license only costs \$19 and allows me to shoot 2 deer and two turkey of either sex. I can hunt from September 15th until November 15th and again from November 27th until January 15th. I can also hunt with my bow during the Regular Firearms season of November 16th thru November 26th if I buy a firearms permit for \$17. On top of that if I want to save my archery any deer permits for bucks I can still shoot as many anterless deer as I want because resident MO archery hunters can purchase any number of anterless permits for \$7 each. Those permits are valid in all of Missouri except for 5 counties in the states bootheel region. Be sure to check out the 2019 Fall Deer and Turkey Hunting Regulations booklet for this year's regulations. So count your blessings Missouri Bowhunters and start practicing in earnest because in 6 more weeks we can hunt!

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Lots of news from the Missouri Department of Conservation over the last month.

- 1. CWD Management Zone reduced by 19 counties for the 2019 season.

 MDC designed the CWD Management Zone in 2012 to include counties within 25 miles of where cases of CWD have been found. Existing research from other states showed that deer may disperse up to 25 miles from where they were born, especially young bucks in search of territory or mates. Recent research by MDC shows that 90% of bucks in Missouri disperse less than 10 miles. Based on that research MDC removed the following counties from the CWD Management zone because they are more than 10 miles from locations where CWD cases have been found: Benton, Bollinger, Callaway, Cape Girardeau, Carroll, Cole, Cooper, Dade, Grundy, Livingston, Madison, McDonald, Miller, Moniteau, Osage, Randolph, Schuyler, Shelby, and St. Louis.

 Three counties were added to the CWD Management Zone: Christian, Howell, and Oregon were added because of recent CWD detections in Oregon, Stone, and Taney counties. Check out https://huntfish.mdc.mo.gov/hunting-trapping/species/deer/regulations for all of the 2019 deer season regulations.
- 2. <u>Possible Missouri Elk Season in 2020.</u>
 According to MDC research, the herd will likely reach 200 animals by 2020. With that in mind, MDC has designated a nine-day archery season for elk running Oct. 17-25, 2020, and a nine-day firearms season for elk running Dec. 12-20, 2020. This is pretty exciting news that we are getting close to an Elk Season in Missouri however it's my personal opinion that it's still at least a couple of years away. - 3. The State of Missouri has increased poaching fines for Deer, Turkey, Paddlefish, Black Bear, and Elk.

 Missouri Governor Michael Parson signed HB260 into law July 11. Called the Poaching Bill, it significantly raises fines for those convicted of illegally taking Missouri game species and other native wildlife. HB260 was sponsored by Representative Jered Taylor (Republic) and Senator Mike Bernskoetter (Jefferson City). New fine amounts include \$10,000-\$15,000 for each elk or black bear killed illegally, \$1,000-\$5,000 for each whitetailed buck, \$500-\$1,000 for each wild turkey, and \$500-\$1,000 for each paddlefish. The fines are considered restitution payments for poaching game animals and are ordered by a judge. Monies from the fines go to the state's school moneys fund. The restitution payments are in addition to other fines and penalties for violating the Wildlife Code of Missouri. The new fines will go into effect Aug. 28.
