



# The Etiquette of Indoor Archery

By Bill Myers

With the State Indoor championship just around the corner I thought this would be a good time to refresh ourselves with some indoor archery etiquette/rules.

- 1) Archers must conduct himself/herself at all times in a manner that will bring respect and honor to himself/herself, archery and MBH.
- 2) Archers shall make every effort to comply with all rules and regulations both published and intended.
- 3) Obscene or vulgar slogans or pictures on clothing are not acceptable.
- 4) Do not touch anyone else's equipment without permission.
- 5) Archers should be able to pull their bow back without pointing higher than the height of their target butt.
- 6) Verbal communication between shooter and any spectators while on the shooting line is not permitted.
- 7) Listen for the whistle to approach the line, start and/or stop shooting.
- 8) Keep your arrows in your quiver until range is clear.
- 9) Archers must straddle the shooting line.
- 10) Always check archers on either side of you before entering and leaving the line. Do not leave or enter the line when an archer is at full draw. Leave the line only if finished shooting or you experience a malfunction.
- 11) If you experience an equipment malfunction, notify a line judge by rising your hand.
- 12) When finished shooting all of your arrows step back from the line and place your bow on the bow rack and wait behind the bow rack.
- 13) Walk (don't run) when going to score and returning with pulled arrows.
- 14) Parents of cubs who have knowledge of how the targets are scored are invited to help with the scoring; but may not help score on the target butt that their child is shooting on. If you would like to help, please notify either the President, Secretary or the person in charge of guardian angels. Not every parent will be allowed to go down range. This only adds confusion and delays the scoring process.
- 15) Parent (s) of youth and young adults are not allowed to help with the scoring.
- 16) If arrows become difficult to score (due to multiple holes in the target) the line judge will require you to replace that target.

I wish everyone shooting the MBH State Indoor Championships at Linn, Mo the very best of luck!
