

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT LIONS, BEARS, & HOGS – OH MY!

It's interesting to me spending a raining morning; we've had a lot of those in the spring of 2019, looking around the Missouri Department of Conservation website for interesting information. One webpage I found led to a couple of hours of learning some updates on Missouri Black Bears and Mountain Lion sightings. You can find out all about recent reports of lion and bear sightings at https://nature.mdc.mo.gov/discover-nature/report-wildlife-sightings



Be sure to open the various links about the Black Bear Project and the YouTube video link. There are 22 videos about Missouri Black Bears with the 30 minute Missouri Black Bear info from April of 2015 being the longest and most informative.
