- 2. Minutes of the last meeting Read and passed
- 3. Review financial statements Read and passed
- 4. Large & Small Game 6 people turned in awards for 2019 so Jeff is not requesting a budget to give out awards. He will continue to go to CFM meetings and stay on the committees. He discussed what is on the CFM agenda. Motion made to keep the CFM budget at \$1,000 and passed.

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

Article II: Dues and Affiliation

January 26, 2020:

Current

- C. A local club may affiliate with MBH, either with or without a charter in NFAA, as follows:
- 1. New MBH and/or NFAA club charter: Each affiliating MBH club have at a minimum five (5) MBH members (Head of Household) and each affiliating NFAA charter shall at a minimum five (5) NFAA members (Head of Household). Affiliating clubs shall pay an initial charter fee in an amount set by the NFAA for an NFAA charter, and the amount set by the B of R to MBH for an MBH charter. Such fees shall be accompanied by the appropriate application(s) and shall be submitted to the MBH Executive Secretary. Such affiliations shall be for a term of one year and shall include charters in NFAA and MBH, and a seat on the MBH B of R as detailed under Article V of these by-laws. Initial application shall be accompanied by a complete MBH member club roster, showing name, mailing address, E-mail address, date of birth, shooting style and telephone number, and an indication of club officers, NFAA members, and the club's representative to the B of R. (Amended 8-24-15)

Proposed:

- **C.** A local club may affiliate with MBH, either with or without a charter in NFAA, as follows:
- 1. MBH club charter only, each affiliating MBH club must have at a minimum three (3) MBH members. An MBH/NFAA charter must have a minimum five (5) NFAA/MBH members (head of household). Affiliating clubs shall pay an initial charter fee in an amount set by the NFAA for a NFAA charter, and the amount set by the B of R for an MBH charter. MBH (only) charters fees shall be accompanied by the appropriate application and shall be submitted to the MBH Executive Secretary. NFAA/MBH charter applications should be completed by going to the NFAA webpage online. Such affiliations (either MBH or MBH/NFAA) shall be for a term of one year and shall include a seat on the MBH B of R as detailed under Article V of these by-laws. Initial application shall be accompanied by a complete MBH member club roster, showing name, mailing address, e-mail address, date of birth, shooting style and telephone number, and an indication of club officers, NFAA members, and the club's representative to the B of R.

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

Article V: Board of Representatives

January 26, 2020:

Current

B Each affiliated club with a minimum of five MBH home club members shall be entitled to one vote through its representative. The vice-president, executive secretary, NFAA representatives, and immediate past president shall not be entitled to vote unless they are duly elected representatives or alternates of their club. The president, as chair of the B of R, may vote only in the case of a tie.

Proposed:

B. Each affiliated club shall be entitled to one vote through its representative. The vice-president, executive secretary, NFAA representatives, and immediate past president shall not be entitled to vote unless they are duly elected representatives or alternates of their club. The president, as chair of the B of R, may vote only in the case of a tie.



- 9. **Jim Brinkmann**, Labadie, killed a 102 lb. Doe on 9/24/19 with a 32 yard shot in Franklin County.
- 10. **Jim Brinkmann**, Labadie, harvested a 70 lb. Doe at 4:30 pm on 10/13/19 with a 25 yard shot in Franklin County.
- 11. **Kathy Brinkmann**, Labadie, joined in on the Oct 13th harvest by killing a 62 lb. Doe of her own at 6:30 pm with an 18 yard shot in Franklin County.
- 12. **Kathy Brinkmann**, Labadie, started the Nov 4th harvest with a 100 lb. Doe shot at 9 am in Franklin County. 15 yard shot.
- 13. **Jim Brinkmann**, Labadie, ended that day with a great P&Y Buck, shot at 5 pm in Franklin County. The 13 point, 176 lb. buck was shot at a distance of 15 yards.
- 14. **Jim Brinkmann**, Labadie, harvested his second buck of the season on 11/16/19. A 162 lb. 8 pt. Buck shot at 8 am at 12 yards in Franklin County.
