### LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

Remember last month when I said I wouldn't hunt opening day because I thought it was too hot and buggy?

We'll I did end up hunting opening evening and yes it was about 80 degrees and the mosquitoes were terrible. My son talked me into going out with him to watch a water hole and scout some public land along the Missouri River. We got there about 4 pm and had to walk about a mile to the water hole which was really just a low spot next to the levy. The levy hadn't been mowed yet so the weeds and grass were about chest high which made for good cover but again buggy. The Thermocell is a lifesaver and it looked kinda promising with lots of tracks around the water. We set up on some low folding chairs with a good view of the crop fields about a mile each way and ranged shots across the water hole. Longest shot would be about 40 yards.

We had been there about an hour and hadn't seen anything but some Killdeer and some Redeared Sliders when we heard some machinery moving our way. Now mind you this was about 5:30pm and we looked at each other thinking surely they didn't pick today to mow the Levy!

Sure enough two big ol tractors pulling brush hogs were headed out way. We quickly gathered up our gear and got down off the side of that levy, where we then watched the mowers annihilate our previous sitting spot. Sometimes it's just not meant to be. We spent the rest of the evening walking the edges of the corn fields and we did see a few does with fawns while we sweated and swatted at the mosquitoes. Another opening day has come and gone for me, I hope yours was better than mine.
