CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

It's OFFICIAL---- MISSOURI WILL HAVE a BLACK BEAR SEASON IN 2021!!!!

The first ever bear season in Missouri will happen October 18 thru 27, 2021 in Southern Missouri.

There are three Bear Management Zones (BMZ) with limited hunting permits and a limited quota of harvested bears for each zone. Only 400 permits will be issued with a total kill quota of 35 bears for the 2021 season. Permits will be a random draw from applications submitted in May. Only Missouri residents are eligible and the application fee is \$10. If you're successfully drawn in July you may then buy a \$25 permit to hunt Missouri Black Bear this October. The 10 day season will close early if the quota is reached before season closes.

It's Spring!!!! Time for 3D Shoots and Spring Turkey Hunting!

I hope you 'all are getting outdoors, Spring is a great new awakening with wildflowers blooming, turkeys gobbling, baby critters being born, and TICKS.

Don't let the ticks keep you from getting into the field to hike ,hunt, fish, and shoot your bow but do prepare for encountering ticks. The best protection I have found is to spray your turkey camo and outdoor clothing with insect repellent containing 0.5% PERMETHRIN. Spray you're gear on a clothesline outside and let it dry. It will last about a month even through washings and it works! It's not cheap but a lot cheaper than getting tick borne illnesses.

My wife and I shot 3D at Carroll County Bowhunters in March. Getting a couple of miles of walking in with shooting 30 or 40 arrows is good exercise. Shooting 3D's is not only great practice it's Fun, so get to one in your area and shoot.



Missouri spring turkey season will be here soon. Opening day is Monday April 19th. Hearing the big birds gobble and being outdoors in the springtime is something I look forward to every spring.
