CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Here's a great article written by Colton Zirkle about a great tool to keep track of what's happening in the Missouri State Legislature concerning conservation in our state. Please sign up and use this tool, its FREE.



Missouri's Conservation Legislative Action Center

What's a little thing you could do that would make a huge impact? Join the Legislative Action Center (LAC)! Last year the Conservation Federation of Missouri (CFM) launched the LAC as a quick and easy way for conservation-minded folks to contact their elected officials. Once a person logs in, they can take action on pieces of legislation with literally two clicks!

By joining the LAC, for free we might add, not only can you take action, but you will be notified with specific Action Alerts. Any time major legislation comes up, an email will be sent to you outlining the issue and requesting your action. Once you follow the link, a pre-filled letter will appear with CFM and associated affiliate's position on the bill. One paragraph is left blank for you to fill in your own comments if you would like. With one more click, you send your email to your state representative and/or senator. After that, you are able to share the "call to action" with your friends on social media and through email.

The LAC showed its strength in February of 2020 when Missouri conservationists rallied together against HJR-100. This resolution would have effectively removed the constitutional authority of the Missouri Department of Conservation to use science to manage our natural resources and would have transferred that authority to politicians. HJR-100 could have had vast and far-reaching impacts on our conservation legacy. An Action Alert was sent out through the LAC and CFM's social media and over 3,000 emails were sent to our state legislators! Concerned citizens rallied together and "packed the House," to oppose this legislation and it was successfully defeated.

Not all issues are as big as HJR-100, but there are many opportunities to share our united conservation voice. Not all of our action items oppose legislation either, some are letters of support.

Also in 2020, HB-1711 was drafted to expand the beloved Share the Harvest program. It passed overwhelmingly through the support of Missourians contacting their legislators through the LAC. HB-1711 paved the way for Share the Harvest to soon include venison "snack sticks," which will be included in programs like Columbia's "Buddy Packs." In this program, food insecure children are sent home over the weekend with backpacks containing shelf-stable food items. Another beautiful way conservation gives back.



Last month I told you that Missouri was on its way to another record archery season. Well the final numbers are in and the archery kill was up by almost 9%.

There were 67,180 deer harvested during the 2020-2021 archery deer season.

Hunters checked 61,407 deer during the 2019-2020 archery deer season.

Top counties for this archery deer season were Jefferson with 1,630, Saint Louis with 1,384 and Franklin with 1,315.

A record 28,742 bucks were killed during archery season, again a 9% increase.

Here is a chart of archery harvest the last 10 years. The last 5 years have included crossbows.

The last 2 years have shown a big increase in archery season kills which has been unprecedented in any previous seasons. I can only believe it's because more and more hunters are using crossbows. We need to keep monitoring it to make sure that's not hurting the deer herd.
