CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT

With the November Firearms deer season coming up in a couple of weeks I wanted to remind you of Missouri's SHARE THE HARVEST PROGRAM. Food prices especially meat have really gone up this year so if you are lucky enough to harvest a deer this fall, please consider donating all or part of it to the program.

Missouri's Share the Harvest program helps deer hunters donate surplus venison to the needy. This program is administered by the Conservation Federation of Missouri and the Missouri Department of Conservation.

Donating is easy. Simply take your deer to an approved meat processor and let the processor know how much venison you wish to donate.

State-wide sponsors of the cost-reduction program include the Conservation Department, Conservation Federation of Missouri, Feeding Missouri, Shelter Insurance, Missouri Chapter National Wild Turkey Federation, Bass Pro Shops, and Gateway Area Chapter of Safari Club International. These sponsors will pay up to \$75 towards processing if you donate the whole deer.

If you wish to donate a deer that was harvested in a county within the CWD Management Zone, the deer must be tested for CWD, and it can only be donated to an approved processor that is participating in the Share the Harvest CWD-Testing Program.

LARGE & SMALL GAME COMMITTEE

I'm writing this on October 25th and now is PRIME TIME Missouri Archery hunting in my book. I may not see as many deer as in the early or late season while watching food plots but the last week of October through the first two weeks of November are the best for catching a mature whitetail buck out cruzing looking foe does with his guard down so I can possibly get an arrow into him. You still must play the wind right for the stand you select to hunt but the bottom line is you need to be on stand as much as you can during these next three weeks. Each year will play out a little differently concerning daily weather patterns, food, & water availability which all need to be considered when choosing which stand to be in. This year on my Hickory County farm we have had a tremendous acorn crop. More than I have every seen in the 21 seasons I've hunted there, but it's been very dry since the first of July which has really limited the areas where the deer can get a drink. Since the deer can find food literally anywhere in the woods I'm going to try and key in on where they are drinking and a couple of small turnip/radish food plots that were planted in a shady creek bottom that have done fairly well growing. I've lots of does and three good 8pt bucks that are mature and on my target list but the oldest buck that I would really like to get is a very wide and old 7pt, that we call Forky. My son and I have been seeing this guy with our eyes and on trail cam for the last 3 years but he continues to elude us. Maybe one of us will tag him this year. Good luck and get you but in a tree stand or blind as much as you can these next three weeks!
