The Conservation Federation of Missouri held it's Awards Banquet on Friday night of the 87th Annual Convention held this year at Margaritaville Lake of the Ozarks.

The are also former CFM Award winners for Conservation Communicators of the year. This year CFM awarded eight students scholarships and seven youth with Student Conservation Awards. 14 more conservation awards were handed out in categories in education, forests, water, wildlife, and legislators.
