

- 4. There will be registration for a team event at state indoor on Saturday night if there are enough team registrations.
- Jim Akers did not find any suitable locations to host the state indoor in the Columbia area.

The Release & Website:

- 1. Terry plans to continue to do the website as his health is better. However, we should consider a backup plan for the near future.
- 2. Terry requested \$485 for website fees. Motion was passed

New/Old Officers:

- 1. Motion to obtain the current officers due to no nominations. Motion passed. Bids for State 600; State Outdoor Field; and State 3D:
 - 1. No bids have been submitted yet. Tabled for a couple of months. Bids can still be submitted.

Conservation Federation Grant:

- Checks have been delivered for Hank Schollmeyer to Backyard Archery; Isabella Cordova-Guerrero to Archery Excellence; Kutter Kyle to Doug Kyle. Still have not heard from Cassandra Haldeman and Brylyn Sweet.
- 7. New Business:
 - 1. Scholarships for 2023 Motion passed to grant scholarships to 5 applications. An certificate ceremony will take place during the state indoor in March.
- 8. Update club charters Tobi emailed the clubs who are expiring in January.

- 10. Additional business Antler scoring event will be in Chillicothe on March 11th.

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE REPORT to MBH Board of Representatives 1/15/23

I have continued to serve at the Conservation Federation of Missouri (CFM) as an Executive Board Member and the Chairman of the Archery and Shooting Sports Committee in 2022. My term expires March 2023.

In 2022 I attended 10 different CFM board meetings, 3 in person and 7 virtual. Missouri held its third Elk season and its second Black Bear season in 2023. In 2022 two elk bulls were killed with archery method. There were 4 Black Bear were taken with archery gear in 2022. There were 8 bears killed in Missouri by hunters in 2022.

Archery Deer Season kill for 2022 is at 54,936 with three days left in the season. It's down again compared to the last two years. 2021 season kill was 59,498 and 2020 was the record year of 67,487 deer harvested with legal archery gear. I don't know how many archery licenses were sold in 2022. I plan to get a report from MDC at the CFM Archery & Shooting Sports Committee meeting during the CFM Convention. I do know that MDC has approved some regulation changes for the 2023 deer season which includes an early October antlerless deer season for rifle hunters. This season will be October 6-8, 2023. MDC is also allowing more antlerless tags in most Missouri counties upping the number from 2 to 4 permits per rifle hunter. During the discussions I've had with MDC deer biologist's they told me that the Missouri deer herd is increasing, and they want more deer harvested to stabilize the increasing herd. The only tool they have is hunters. Hunter numbers are holding steady in Missouri but however the deer harvest totals have been about the same the last 3 years with kill totals running between 295,000 to 298,000 each year. Archery hunters aren't killing enough deer, especially does, so rifle hunters are getting extra tags and seasons to kill more does.

At this time CFM doesn't foresee any new legislative bills filed having the potential to pass that would negatively affect Conservation but we will continue to monitor and alert everyone if something comes up.

The annual CFM Convention in February will be a combination virtual & in-person event this year happening February 21-26, 2023. The in-person event will be at Margaritaville Resort on Lake of the Ozarks February 24-26, 2023. Details are available at https://www.confedmo.org/convention/

CFM Affiliate yearly dues for MBH will again be \$300 for 2023.
