

MBH will be seeking nominations or volunteers for the following offices:

Duties of MBH Officers

**President** – It shall be his/her duty to preside at all meetings of MBH and the BofR. He/she shall appoint standing and special committee chairs from the BofR and perform all other duties pertaining to the office. The President will appoint a Parliamentarian who is an MBH member in good standing. The President will nominate a Executive Secretary for approval by the BofR. The President will nominate a NFAA State Director for approval by the BofR.

**Vice-President** – It shall be his/her duty to preside and to act in the absence of the President. He/she will attend all meetings of MBH and the BofR.

Nomination from the BofR or MBH members will be accepted at the August meeting of the BofR. Ballots will be mailed out to MBH members in December (returned before the January meeting) and counted at the January meeting at which time the new President and Vice-President will be installed by the outgoing President.



Spring Turkey Season Is Almost Here!



Youth Season (ages 6-15) is April 6-7. The rest of us get to start hunting in Missouri on Monday April 15th until May 5th, 2024!

All the regulations are the same as in the past several years with one very notable exception. This year you are allowed to hunt all day on private land. Public land will still close at 1pm.

Hunting hours on private land only are ½ hour before sunrise until sunset this year. Also, the Spring Season Turkey Hunting Permit went up this year. The cost is \$18 for resident adults and \$9 for all youth. Non-resident adult permits will cost \$233.50 and Non-resident landowners permits will cost \$172. Non-resident landowners must own at least 75 acres in one contiguous tract to be eligible for the reduced cost non-resident landowner permit.

#### CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

I attended the Conservation Federation of Missouri's 88th Annual Convention last weekend. It seems like it usually happens the same weekend that MBH holds its State Indoor Shoot, so I haven't been able to shoot for a few years. This year's convention was held at the Lodge of the Four Seasons in Lake Ozark, MO. Friday night is the awards banquet, CFM handed out several awards and scholarships to students across the state that are pursuing careers in conservation and wildlife management. A new award this year that was created by MBH Hall of Famer Dick Wood was called "Share the Harvest Processor of the Year". Dick proposed the award and nominated our first recipient, John's Butcher Shoppee in Festus, MO. This processing plant has been involved with Share the Harvest to process deer that is then given to folks in need at no charge. They have been a Share the Harvest processor since the inception of the program over 30 years ago. Great idea Dick and thanks for your continued support and activities in CFM and MBH.

Saturday morning started with agency addresses from DNR director Dru Buntin and Missouri Department of Conservation Director Sara Parker Pauley. It's an informative presentation about what's been going on for the last year across Missouri in our State Parks, water and soil quality protections, lakes and streams, fisheries and hatcheries, forests, and wildlife. Always informative and mostly positive news from these addresses.

The rest of Saturday is filled with Education Seminars about outdoors and conservation in Missouri. Saturday night is the banquet, silent auction, raffles, live auction, and the Keynote Speakers Presentation. This year's keynote speakers were Mark and Terry Drury from Drury Outdoors. These well-known speakers have been involved in the outdoor industry since 1989 when they started filming their own turkey hunts and selling VHS tapes. These are Missouri born and raised boys and their love of Missouri Outdoors was evident during the 45 minutes they talked and told stories about growing up in rural Missouri. Even Miss Missouri for 2023 Hayley Leach was there wearing her fur coat donated by the Missouri Trappers Association. If you every want to have a great weekend learning, socializing, eating, drinking (yep I said free beer and wine on Saturday night sponsored by St James Winery and Public House Brewing Company), and raising money at the raffles, silent, and live auctions with a bunch of likeminded Missouri Outdoor folks then plan on attending next year.
